**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING MOTION
FOR PARTY STATUS**

On December 18, 2025, San Diego Gas and Electric Company
(SDG&E) filed the instant Application.

On January 30, 2026, Small Business Utility Advocates (SBUA) filed a motion for party status (Motion) pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure (Rule) 1.4. SBUA represents SDG&E's small commercial customers whose electric rates are determined in this proceeding. The Motion is based on the grounds that SBUA represents the specific interests of SDG&E's small business commercial customers. SBUA seeks to actively participate and represent SDG&E's small commercial customers whose rates are impacted by the instant Application.¹

Having reviewed the Motion there is good cause to grant the Motion pursuant to Rule 1.4. This Ruling grants SBUA's Motion.
