**WHO INITIATED THE COMMUNICATION:** SCE

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNICATION:** The Joint IOUs recommended revisions to the proposed decision requiring 2029-2032 electric resource procurement, including the need for continued use of the alternative compliance mechanism in Decision 25-09-007 and consideration of good faith efforts before assessing penalties to address project development delays and avoid unnecessary cost increases to customers; consideration of the California Energy Commission's 2025 Integrated Energy Policy Report ("IEPR") lower load forecast to either lower the 2032 procurement requirement by 2 GW or delay the 2032 procurement, followed by a reevaluation of the 2032 target using the 2025 IEPR when effective load carrying capability ("ELCC") values are determined; the need for clarity on ELCC values to ensure procurement targets are feasible and explicitly allow the extension of the Diablo Canyon Power Plant to count towards this procurement order if permitted under statute; and clarification that the proposed 50% cap on storage resources, if retained, does not apply to the storage portion of hybrid or co-located resources.
