**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING ORDERING PARTIES
TO MEET AND CONFER AND FILE A JOINT STATUS UPDATE**

The February 13, 2026 Proposed Decision in this proceeding approves and modifies the Settlement Agreement entered into by Liberty Utilities, the Public Advocates Office, The Utility Reform Network, A-3 Customer Coalition, Small Business Utility Advocates and the Tahoe Energy Ratepayers Group (TERG) (collectively the Settling Parties).

On March 5, 2026, TERG filed its Opening Comments to the Proposed Decision and rejected the Proposed Decision's modification to the Settlement Agreement.

The Settling Parties are ordered to meet and confer and file a Joint Status Update by March 13, 2026. Liberty Utilities shall coordinate the scheduling of the meet and confer and the filing of the Joint Status Update.

The meet and confer and Joint Status Update will address how the Settling Parties propose the Commission proceed with resolving this proceeding in light of TERG's Opening Comments to the Proposed Decision. The Joint Status Update

will reflect (1) the positions of each of the Settling Parties, (2) if there is disagreement among the Settling Parties, an explanation of the differing positions, and (3) a proposed schedule for resolving this proceeding.

IT IS RULED that:

The Settling Parties are ordered to meet and confer and file a Joint Status Update by March 13, 2026, in accordance with the provisions of this Ruling as set forth above.
