ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE DUGOWSON: The Commission will come to order.

We are now on the record. Today is January 16th, 2026, and this is the prehearing conference for Rulemaking 25-08-004, the Order Instituting Rulemaking to Update Distribution Level Interconnection Rules and Regulations.

I'm Administrative Law Judge, or ALJ, Andrew Dugowson, and I'm assigned to this proceeding. The assigned commissioner is Commission President Alice Reynolds. President Reynolds could not join us today, but a representative from her office may be on the line.

The purpose of this prehearing conference is to determine the parties, the categorization, the need for hearings, and discuss next steps for procedure -- proceeding scope and procedural schedule.

Give me just one second.

First, I will take appearances in alphabetical order from parties that sent me an email indicating they planned to attend. I will then give requests for party status. When I call on you, please state and then spell your first and last name, then indicate how you prefer

1 to be addressed; for example, I will refer to our court
2 reporter as Reporter De Rosa. For the benefit of
3 Reporter De Rosa, speak speak slowly and clearly.

4 First, Advanced Energy United.

5 MR. TURNER: Good morning, your Honor. My name
6 is Brian Turner, B-r-i-a-n T-u-r-n-e-r -- that's how I
7 prefer to be called -- representing Advanced Energy
8 United. Thank you.

9 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Ava Community
10 Energy.

11 MS. HUANG: Good morning, your Honor, Claire
12 Huang representing Ava Community Energy, C-l-a-i-r-e
13 H-u-a-n-g, and you may refer to me by my first and last
14 name. Thank you.

15 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Bear Valley and the
16 other SMJUs.

17 MR. GIBSON: Good morning, your Honor, Jed
18 Gibson, J-e-d G-i-b-s-o-n, on behalf of Bear Valley
19 Electric Service, Liberty Utilities, and PacifiCorp; but
20 collectively, the -- the three small utilities are known
21 as the Small Multi-Jurisdictional Utilities, or SMJUs,
22 or the California Association of Small and
23 Multi-Jurisdictional Utilities, or CASMU. Thank you.

24 ALJ DUGOWSON: Ah, CASMU. Thank you,
25 Mr. Gibson.

1 Cal Advocates.

2 MR. HILL: Yes. Thank you, your Honor. Rod
3 Hill for Cal Advocates; first name is spelled R-o-d,
4 last name is spelled H-i-l-l. And I'm joined by Anthony
5 Abdallah.

6 And go ahead, Anthony.

7 MR. ABI ABDALLAH: Hello, your Honor. My
8 name's Anthony Abi Abdallah, and that's spelled
9 A-n-t-h-o-n-y space A-b-i space A-b-d-a-l-l-a-h. Thank
10 you.

11 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you, both.

12 California -- CalCCA.

13 MR. JOHNSTON: Good morning, your Honor. Kevin
14 Johnston, K-e-v-i-n J-o-h-n-s-t-o-n, for California
15 Community Choice Association, or CalCCA. Thank you.

16 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. California Solar and
17 Storage Association.

18 MR. LUO: Good morning, your Honor. My name is
19 Kevin Luo, spelled K-e-v-i-n, and then last name spelled
20 L-u-o, representing the California Solar and Storage
21 Association. You can just refer to me by my first and
22 last name. Thank you.

23 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. CESA.

24 MR. MURTISHAW: Good morning, your Honor. My
25 name is Scott Murtishaw, S-c-o -- S-c-o M-u-r-t-i-s

1 (indecipherable).

2 ALJ DUGOWSON: To save you the -- thank you,
3 Mr. Murtishaw. I -- I can tell that the reporter
4 couldn't hear. So I will spare you, with your
5 laryngitis, spelling it out, and tell me if I'm wrong.

6 I believe his name is spelled S-c-o-t-t
7 M-u-r-t-i-s-h-a-w.

8 Is that correct?

9 MR. MURTISHAW: (Inaudible response.)

10 ALJ DUGOWSON: I see a nod. Thank you.

11 MR. MURTISHAW: (Indecipherable.)

12 ALJ DUGOWSON: Enphase.

13 MR. MONBOUQUETTE: Thank you, your Honor. Marc
14 Monbouquette with Enphase Energy, Inc., also known as
15 Enphase. My name is M-a-r-c M-o-n-b-o-u-q-u-e-t-t-e.
16 And you can refer to me as Marc.

17 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Ford.

18 MR. WOOD: Hello. Good morning. This is
19 Carter Wood from Ford Motor Company; first name
20 C-a-r-t-e-r, last name W-o-o-d, and you can refer to me
21 as my first and last name. Thank you.

22 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Foundation
23 Windpower.

24 MR. SHERR: Good morning. My name is Steve
25 Sherr with Foundation Windpower, and that's spelled

1 S-t-e-v-e S-h-e-r-r. Thank you.

2 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Green Power
3 Institute.

4 MR. MORRIS: Hi. Greg -- Greg Morris for the
5 Green Power Institute, G-r-e-g-o-r-y M-o-r-r-i-s, and
6 you can call me Greg.

7 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. IREC.

8 MS. STANFIELD: Good morning. I'm Sky
9 Stanfield with Shute, Mihaly & Weinberger on behalf of
10 the Interstate Renewable Energy Council, or IREC, and my
11 name is spelled S-k-y S-t-a-n-f-i-e-l-d, and you can
12 just call me Sky.

13 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. PearlX.

14 MR. STERNS: Good morning, your Honor. My name
15 is Patrick Sterns with PearlX Infrastructure Partners,
16 also known as PearlX. My name is spelled P-a-t-r-i-c-k
17 S-t-e-r-n-s, and you can just call me by my first name.
18 Thank you.

19 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. PG&E.

20 MS. MERLO: Good morning, your Honor. Ashley
21 Merlo for Pacific Gas and Electric Company. That's
22 A-s-h-l-e-y M-e-r-l-o. You can refer to me as Ashley or
23 Ms. Merlo. Thank you.

24 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. SCE.

25 MR. HUERTA: Good morning, your Honor. This is

1 Gerardo Huerta, G-e-r-a-r-d-o, last name H-u-e-r-t-a,
2 representing and appearing on behalf of Southern
3 California Edison Company, and you can refer to me as
4 Jerry, J-e-r-r-y.

5 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. SEIA.

6 MS. ARMSTRONG: Yes. Can you hear me?

7 ALJ DUGOWSON: Loud and clear.

8 MS. ARMSTRONG: Great. Jeanne Armstrong on
9 behalf of SEIA. That's J-e-a-n-n-e Armstrong,
10 A-r-m-s-t-r-o-n-g, and you can refer to me as Jeanne or
11 Ms. Armstrong.

12 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Tesla.

13 MR. SCHWARTZ: Good morning, your Honor. Andy
14 Schwartz on behalf of Tesla; first name A-n-d-y, last
15 name S-c-h-w-a-r-t-z, and you can refer to me as Andy or
16 Mr. Schwartz. Thanks.

17 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. TURN.

18 (No response.)

19 ALJ DUGOWSON: Hearing no response, I'll move
20 to Vehicle-Grid Integration Council.

21 MS. PRATT: Thank you, your Honor. Grace Pratt
22 on behalf of the Vehicle-Grid Integration Council, or
23 VGIC. My name is spelled G-r-a-c-e P-r-a-t-t, and you
24 can refer to me as Grace. Thank you.

25 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. And Vote Solar.

1 MS. MYERS: Good morning. Megan Myers on
2 behalf of Vote Solar. It's M-e-g-a-n Myers, M-y-e-r-s.
3 Thank you.

4 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. I believe that is
5 all of the -- oh, SDG&E. Forgive me.

6 MR. NEWLANDER: You passed the test, your
7 Honor. This is Jonathan Newlander for San Diego Gas &
8 Electric Company. My name is spelled J-o-n-a-t-h-a-n
9 N-e-w-l-a-n-d-e-r, and you can call me Jon or
10 Mr. Newlander, or whatever else strikes your fancy.
11 Thank you.

12 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you very much.

13 Is there anyone else on the line with party
14 status whom I've missed?

15 (No response.)

16 ALJ DUGOWSON: Hearing none, I will next move
17 to motions for party status.

18 Is there anyone on the line who wishes to
19 become a party to this proceeding? Please use the chat
20 function or the raise hands function, if possible.

21 Dean Taylor.

22 (Line muted.)

23 ALJ DUGOWSON: Mr. Taylor, you're on mute.
24 While you resolve your AV issues, I'll move to -- I've
25 seen Wendy Chou or Chou. Forgive me.

1 Would you -- can you unmute yourself?

2 MS. CHOU: Hi. Good morning, your Honor. My
3 name is Wendy Chou.

4 ALJ DUGOWSON: Chou.

5 MS. CHOU: First name's spelled W-e-n-d-y, last
6 name's spelled C-h-o-u, and I represent Acterra: Action
7 for a Healthy Planet, and I would like to request party
8 status at this time.

9 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. If you would, could
10 you please say what your interest in this proceeding is
11 and how it relates to an issue we intend to resolve and
12 how you intend to participate?

13 MS. CHOU: We have been a party to the
14 proceeding 23-08-012, and we are a nonprofit that is
15 concerned with clean energy transition, especially with
16 equity considerations, and we are located in the San
17 Francisco Bay area, which has a number of innovative
18 trends going on that we would like to be a part of, in
19 terms of representing the interests of underserved
20 communities.

21 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Does anyone object
22 to this motion?

23 (No response.)

24 ALJ DUGOWSON: Hearing and seeing none, your --
25 Acterra's: Action for a Healthy Planet's motion for

1 party status is granted.

2 (Acterra: Action for a Healthy Planet was
3 granted Party Status.)

4 MS. CHOU: Thank you, your Honor.

5 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you.

6 I will return to Mr. Taylor.

7 MR. TAYLOR: Hello, your Honor. Can you hear
8 me?

9 ALJ DUGOWSON: Yes.

10 MR. TAYLOR: I'm a consultant for Natural
11 Resources Defense Council. We filed reply comments
12 earlier on this docket, and we would like to be a party.

13 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you. Just as before,
14 could you please state your interest in the proceeding
15 and how it relates to an issue we intend to resolve?

16 MR. TAYLOR: I think our reply comments went
17 into a lot of detail. We commented on almost every
18 issue raised in the earlier docket. We're a national
19 nonprofit that has been very active in similar
20 proceedings like the high DER and the interconnection
21 DER, interested in vehicle grid integration and related
22 issues to Rule 21.

23 ALJ DUGOWSON: Thank you.

24 Does anyone object to this motion?

25 (No response.)

1 ALJ DUGOWSON: Hearing and seeing none, NRDC's
2 oral motion for party stand -- status is granted.

3 (NRDC was granted Party Status.)

4 ALJ DUGOWSON: Are there any other parties who
5 would -- rather, entities who would like to request
6 party status?

7 (No response.)

8 ALJ DUGOWSON: Hearing and seeing none, I will
9 move on.

10 Reporter De Rosa, did I see you make a gesture?
11 Do you need anything?

12 THE REPORTER: (Inaudible response.)

13 ALJ DUGOWSON: No. Thank you.

14 Now that appearances are concluded, I would
15 like to thank all of you who, as Mr. Taylor mentioned,
16 submitted such detailed and thoughtful comments. The
17 president's office and I are still working through your
18 comments, so I do not have a draft scoping memo or
19 schedule to share with you at this time; but, my hope is
20 to issue a scoping ruling and memo in the next few
21 weeks.

22 My only procedural note, which will be outlined
23 in the scoping memo, but is often missed, is that
24 documents should be sent only via email, unless
25 otherwise instructed; in other words, please do not send

1 physical mail to the Commission, unless specifically
2 requested to do so.

3 Next, I will state that the preliminary
4 categorization of this proceeding is quasi-legislative.

5 Does any party oppose this or have any comments
6 on this matter?

7 (No response.)

8 ALJ DUGOWSON: Seeing and hearing none, I will
9 move on.

10 Before I conclude this prehearing conference,
11 I'll take any procedural questions parties might have.
12 As before, if you could use the raise hand or chat
13 function, I would appreciate it.

14 (No response.)

15 ALJ DUGOWSON: Seeing and hearing none, that
16 concludes this prehearing conference. I appreciate you
17 all for being on time, and again, for all of your
18 detailed comments. Thanks for your participation and
19 thank you -- oh, Ms. -- excuse me. Reporter De Rosa?

20 THE REPORTER: Can we go off the record, your
21 Honor?

22 ALJ DUGOWSON: Of course. We're off the
23 record.

24 (Off the record.)

25 ALJ DUGOWSON: I will go back on the record.

1 Dean, would you care to speak?

2 MR. TAYLOR: Can you repeat the email again
3 from the court reporter?

4 ALJ DUGOWSON: We'll go off the record.

5 (Off the record.)

6 ALJ DUGOWSON: We'll go back on the record.

7 Andy, you have a question?

8 MR. SCHWARTZ: Yeah. I was wondering if there
9 are new issues that have surfaced since the opening
10 comments were filed on the OIR, do you envision there
11 being an opportunity to put those additional issues on
12 the record prior to or after the scoping memo is issued?

13 ALJ DUGOWSON: Can I interpret that as a
14 request, or are you just asking generally if there are
15 anything that we've seen?

16 MR. SCHWARTZ: It would -- it would be a
17 request.

18 ALJ DUGOWSON: Okay. I'll take that back to
19 the commissioner. I personally would like to give as
20 much opportunity for parties to surface issues as
21 possible. So I'll take that under consideration, but
22 can't guarantee. Thank you.

23 MR. SCHWARTZ: Yeah. Thank you, your Honor.

24 ALJ DUGOWSON: Anything else?

25 (No response.)
