**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S RULING CORRECTING TABLE IN
JANUARY 16, 2026 FILING REQUIREMENTS RULING AND CONFIRMING
AUGUST 10, 2026 INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN DUE DATE**

The scoping memo and ruling in this proceeding set the date for the filing of the next set of individual integrated resource plans (IRPs) by individual load-serving entities (LSEs) under the Commission’s IRP purview as May 5, 2026. An Administrative Law Judge’s (ALJ’s) ruling dated January 16, 2026 in this proceeding modified the due date to be June 1, 2026. In response to a request for delay from several parties, an email ruling issued March 9, 2026 further modified the due date of the individual LSE IRPs to be August 10, 2026. This ruling confirms the required August 10, 2026 filing date for the individual LSE IRPs. Any party may file an initial set of comments in response to any or all individual IRPs by no later than September 21, 2026.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Table 1 in the January 16, 2026 Administrative Law Judge’s Ruling Setting Requirements for Individual Integrated Resource Plans in this proceeding shall be corrected as given in Table 1 of this ruling.

2. Load serving entities under the Commission's integrated resource planning purview shall file and serve their individual integrated resource plans by no later than August 10, 2026.

3. Any party may file and serve an initial set of comments on any or all individual load serving entity integrated resource plans by no later than September 21, 2026.
