**Subject:** A.24-07-020; Email Ruling Regarding Steps for E-Filing Exhibits and Admission of Exhibits and Requiring Submission of a Word version of the Joint Settlement

To the Parties and Service List:

This ruling clarifies the current proper procedure for referencing e-filed exhibits, including the prepared testimony and exhibits listed in the Joint Motion of the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and The Utility Reform Network (TURN) for Admission of Testimony and Workpapers into Evidence (Joint Motion).

The moving parties' Joint Motion provides a link to that portion of the Commission's website through which the public may access non-docket items that have been e-filed in a Commission proceeding including prepared testimony

and other types of exhibits supporting a party's position. However, the Commission currently requires use of an "E-File Confirmation Number" to retrieve such materials through the Commission's website. PG&E and TURN (Joint Movants) provided only a chart listing the materials they have e-filed in this proceeding by title. No E-File Confirmation Numbers were provided. This oversight prevents others from accessing the materials that the Joint Movants e-filed. The Joint Movants' must correct this oversight by adding their E-File Confirmation Numbers to the chart in the Joint Motion which lists the prepared testimony and exhibits they wish admitted or providing direct links to each of the proffered evidentiary items.

A ruling on the Joint Motion will be issued when an amended Joint Motion is filed containing a means (e.g., the Confirmation Numbers or direct links) for me and the public to access the exhibits proffered by the Joint Applicants. The Joint Applicants should take care to ensure that the confirmation numbers or links will in fact allow the public to access each of the proffered exhibits. Links that connect a reader directly to the targeted document should be tested to be certain that the link is not disabled if the document containing the chart is made into a pdf by the Joint Movants.

Finally, the Joint Movants shall provide to me alone a Word version of their Settlement Agreement by email.

Accordingly, IT IS RULED that PG&E and TURN shall within five business days of this ruling take the steps and provide the information and Word document described above.
