**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING CORRECTING ERROR
IN STAFF PROPOSAL REDLINED HANDBOOK INCLUDED WITH
JANUARY 26, 2026 ADMINSTRATIVE LAW JUDGE RULING**

This ruling corrects an error in the Staff Proposal: Redlined Disadvantaged Communities – Single-Family Solar Homes (DAC-SASH) Program Handbook (Redlined Handbook) included as Attachment B with the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Ruling Seeking Comments on Modifications to DAC-SASH issued on January 26, 2026, (January 26 ALJ Ruling). Page 1 of the Redlined Handbook incorrectly stated that:

“The CPUC authorized \$10M per year to be collected for DAC-SASH, beginning on January 1, 2019, until June 30, 2026.”

The Redlined Handbook should have read:

“The CPUC authorized \$10M per year to be collected for DAC-SASH, beginning on January 1, 2019, until December 31, 2030.”

Ordering Paragraph (OP) 8 of Decision (D.) 18-06-027 established an annual budget of \$10 million for the DAC-SASH program beginning on January 1, 2019, through the end of 2030. While greenhouse gas allowance proceed allocations to DAC-SASH are scheduled to end on June 30, 2026, OP 8 of D.18-06-027 states that:

“If such funds are exhausted, the DAC-SASH program will be funded through public purpose program funds through the conclusion of the program in 2030.”

IT IS RULED that:

1. The statement “The CPUC authorized \$10M per year to be collected for DAC-SASH, beginning on January 1, 2019 until June 30, 2026.” on Page 1 of the Redlined Handbook included as Attachment B with the January 26 ALJ Ruling is corrected to read “The CPUC authorized \$10M per year to be collected for DAC-SASH, beginning on January 1, 2019 until December 31, 2030.”
