**I. TURN Supports the Proposed Decision**

On March 20, 2026, the Commission served the Proposed Decision Denying Southern California Gas Company’s Request for Cost Recovery from Ratepayers for Phase 2 Activities for Angeles Link Project (“Proposed Decision”). TURN files these opening comments on the Proposed Decision pursuant to Rule 14.3 of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure.

The Proposed Decision would deny Southern California Gas Company’s request to implement revenue requirement for costs of the Phase 1 Activities for the Angeles Link Project, determining that such a denial is reasonable.<sup>1</sup> TURN strongly supports the PD without modification and urges the Commission adopt the Proposed Decision.
