The application of Roy H. Halim Machmur d/b/a Liberty Day Express, hereinafter referred to as "Applicant", respectfully states:

The exact name of Applicant is Roy H. Halim Machmur, Sole Proprietor, which will do business as Liberty Day Express, a fictitious business name filed in accordance with California laws. A copy of the fictitious business name statement filed with the Orange County Clerk-Recorder is attached to the original of the application only as **Exhibit A**.

The principal place of business is located at 744 Wycliffe, Irvine, California 92602, including phone number 949-466-3988.

The names, titles, and address of the various officers of the company or owners or partners, and their interests are as follows:

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 1031, Applicant requests to expand its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as an on-call passenger stage corporation, for the

transportation of passengers between points in Orange County and points in San Diego County, which included, but not limited to various points on Camp Pendleton to the Outlets at San Clemente and the Oceanside Transit Center. The proposed fares to be assessed for this service, and rules and regulations governing the same, are as set forth in **Exhibit B** attached hereto.

To keep its fares competitive, Applicant requests Commission's approval to establish a Zone of Rate Freedom (ZORF) of \$10 above and below the proposed fares set forth in **Exhibit B**, pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 454.2. All proposed fares are over \$10, therefore application of ZORF would never result in a fare of zero. Applicant's on-call passenger stage transportation service will operate in competition with other passenger transportation services (including but not limited to taxicabs, transportation network companies, and charter-party carriers), and the authorized ZORF together with such competition will result in reasonable rates and charges for the passenger stage transportation service.

The proposed time schedule between the points to be served is as set forth in **Exhibit C** attached hereto. Service is non-scheduled and operates on-demand; passengers request transportation via phone, app, or other designated method. While applicant dispatches a vehicle as promptly as possible based on driver/vehicle availability. Service is performed under conditions outlined in both **Exhibit B**, *Proposed Fare, Rules, and Regulations*, and **Exhibit C**, *Time Schedule & On-Call Service Description*. A map showing the proposed route of operations is attached hereto as **Exhibit D**.

A description of the equipment to be operated in the proposed service is as shown in **Exhibit E** attached hereto.

A financial statement of Applicant is attached hereto as **Exhibit F**.

Public convenience and necessity require a grant of authority requested by the applicant for the following reasons: By issuing Applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity to establish and operate as a passenger stage corporation, the public will benefit from having a safe and efficient form of transportation that the public knows it can trust. Applicant's service significantly benefits, in particular, military personnel that do not own a personal vehicle,


individuals that want to avoid parking and traffic, and those in the need of transportation that public transit is not available to travel to desired locations. Applicant's service is also beneficial to the environment because it will reduce the number of single-occupancy vehicle trips in the service area, thereby helping to decrease traffic congestion and associated vehicle emissions.

The names of all county and city governmental entities, regional transportation planning agencies and public transit operators within whose boundaries passengers will be loaded or unloaded are attached hereto as **Exhibit G**.

Lastly, **Exhibit H** is simply additional documentation provided by Applicant regarding current licensing and privileges with the California Public Utilities Commission and Camp Pendleton.

Wherefore, Applicant prays that certificate be granted authorizing the operation of the service hereinabove described and for such further order as may be proper.

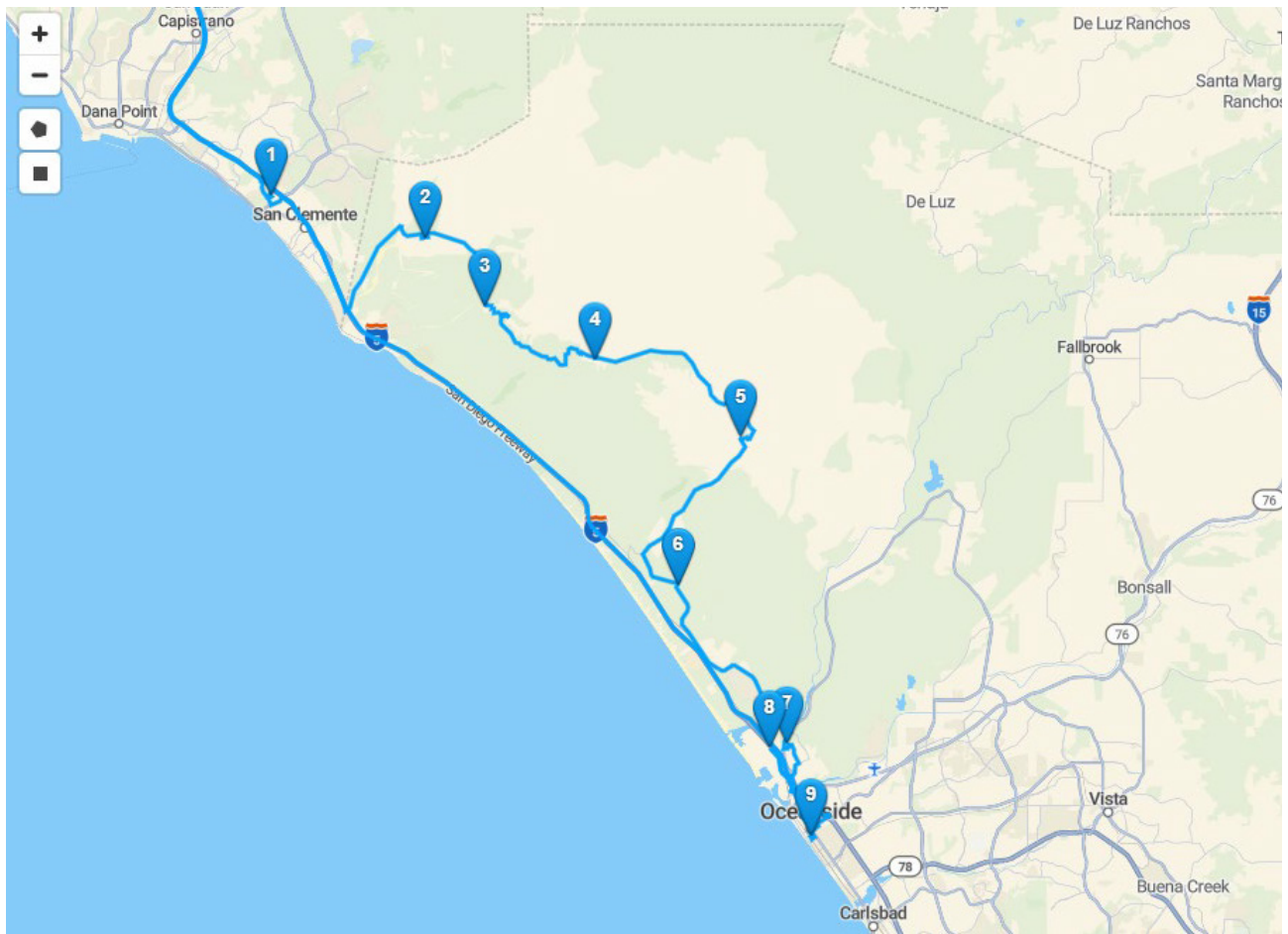
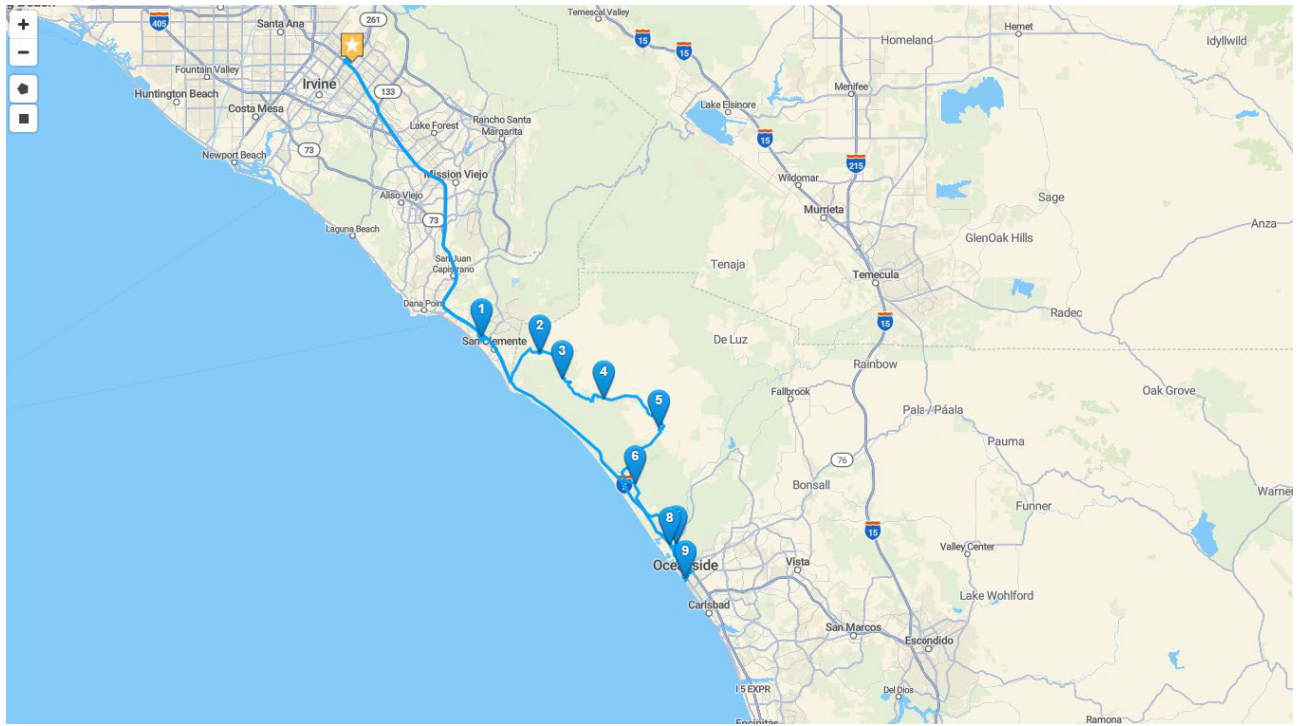

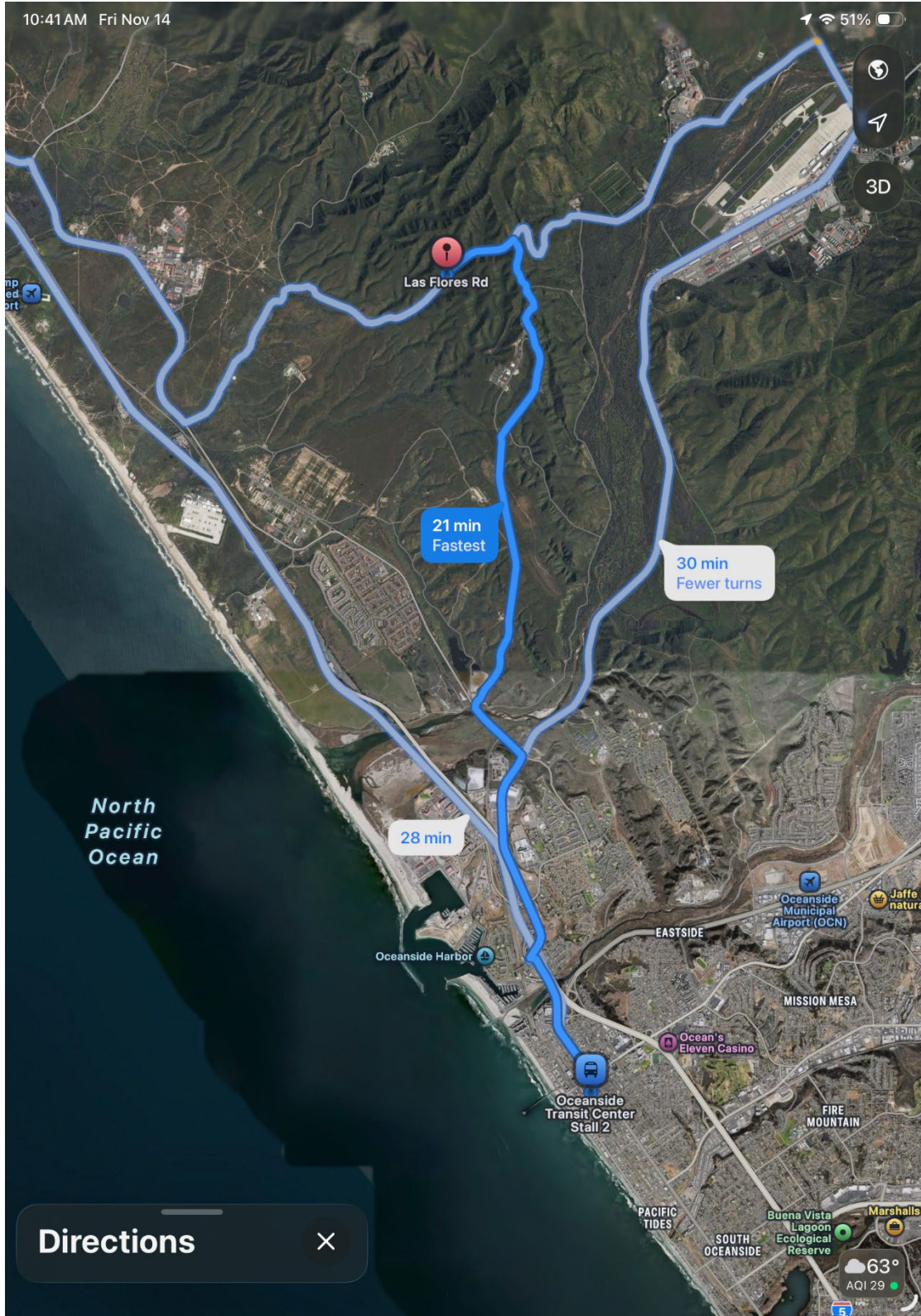
All Pick Up & Drop Off Locations Plotted



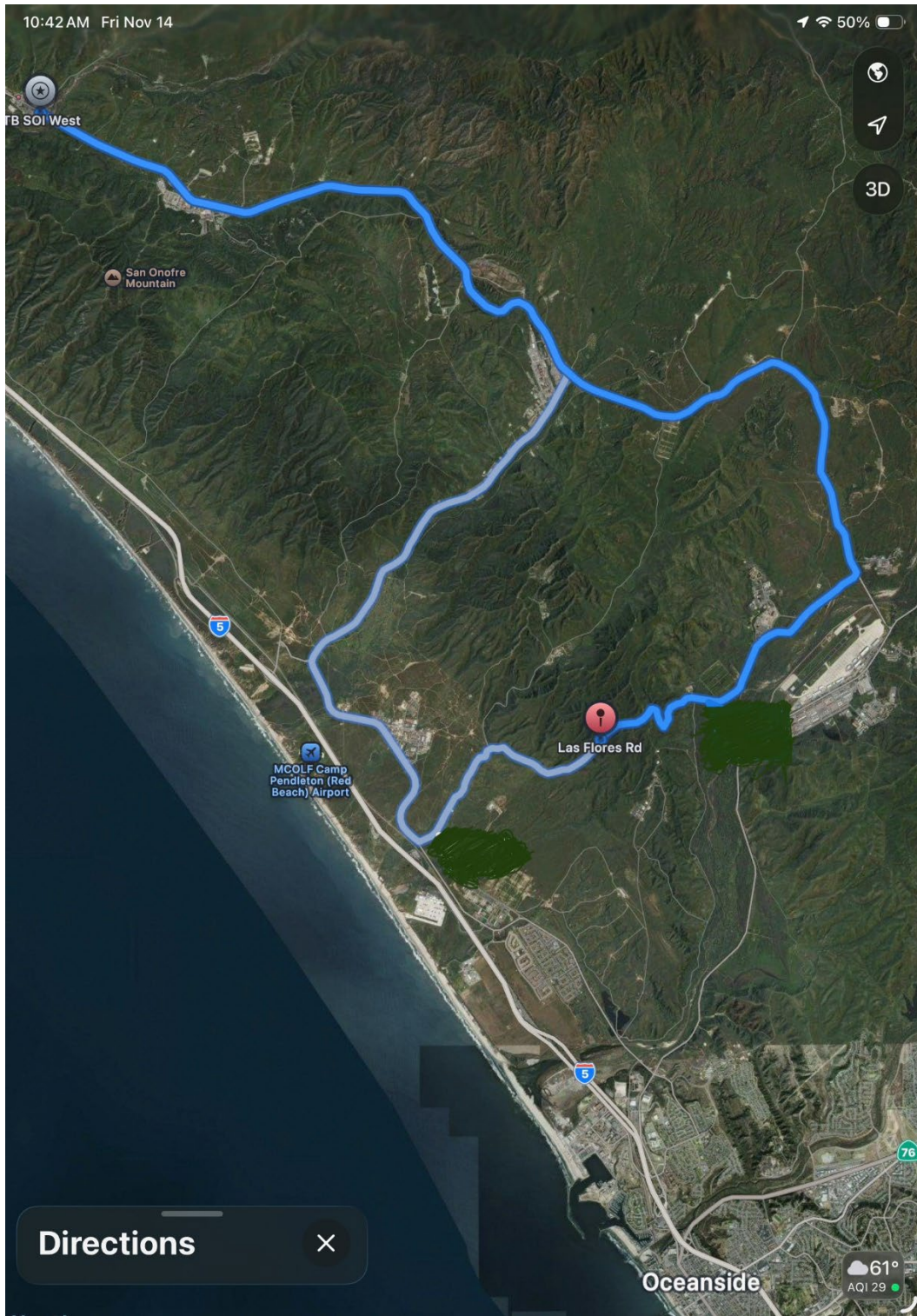

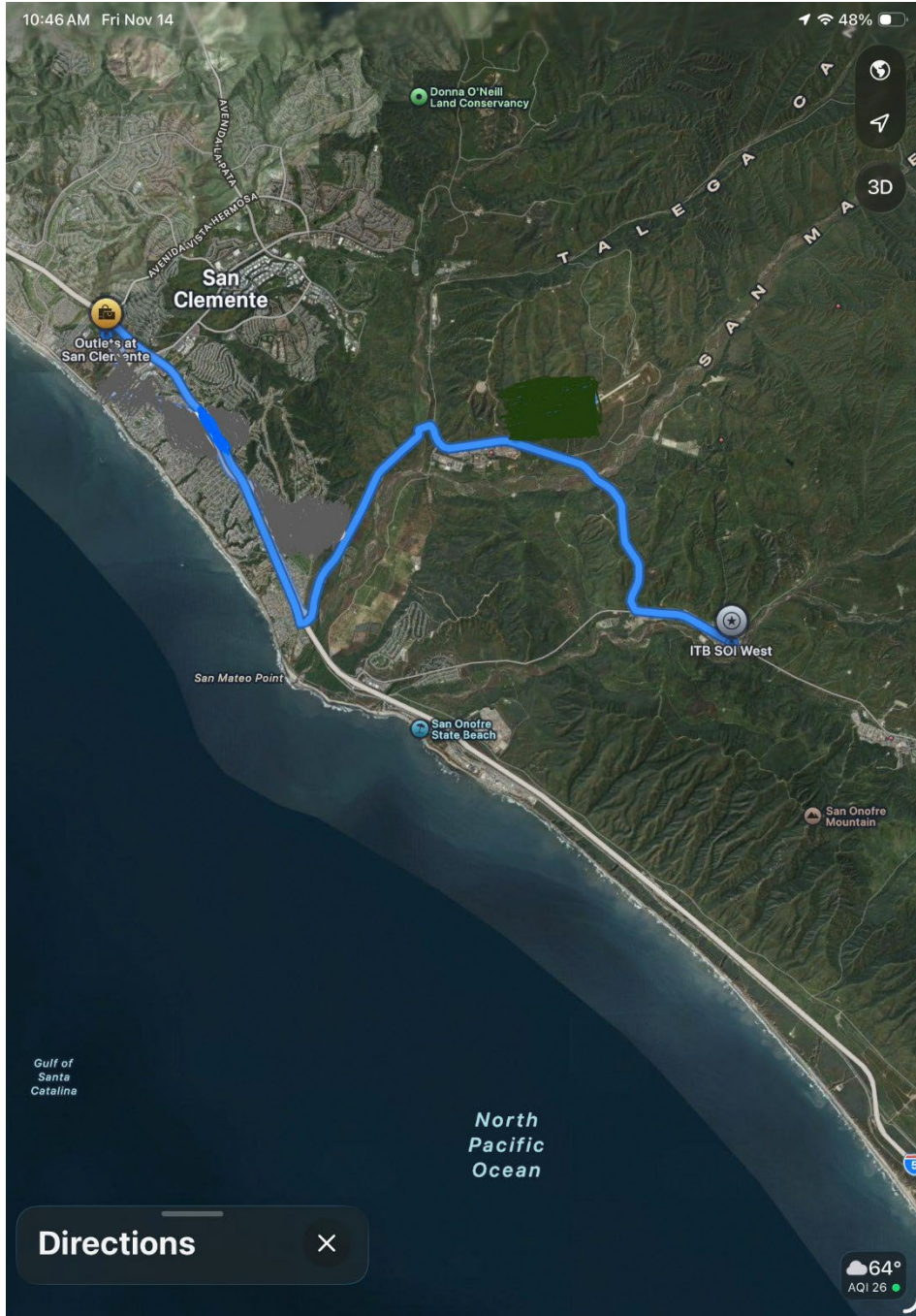

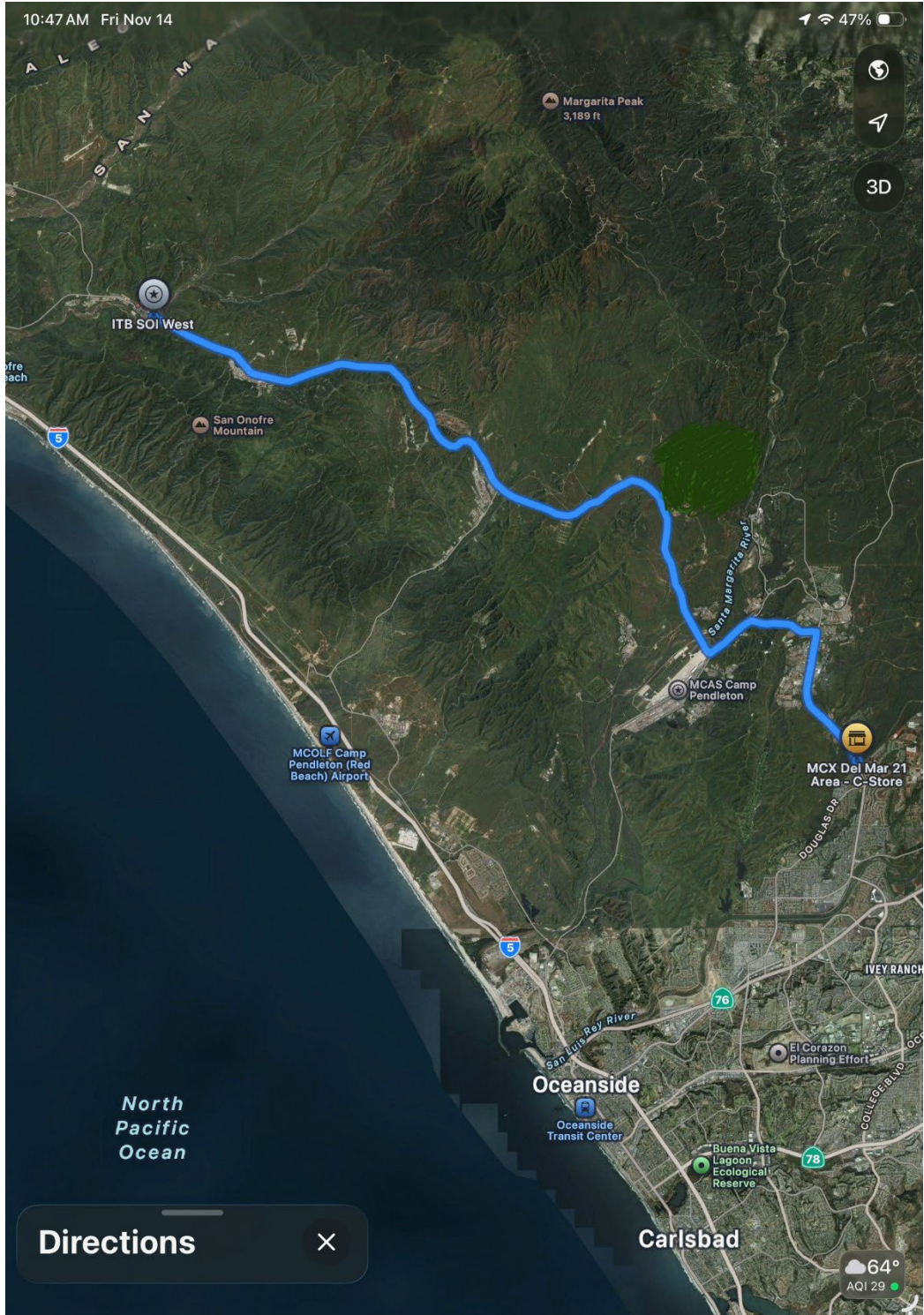
From: Camp Pendleton – 41 Area To: Camp Pendleton – 52 Area (SOI West)



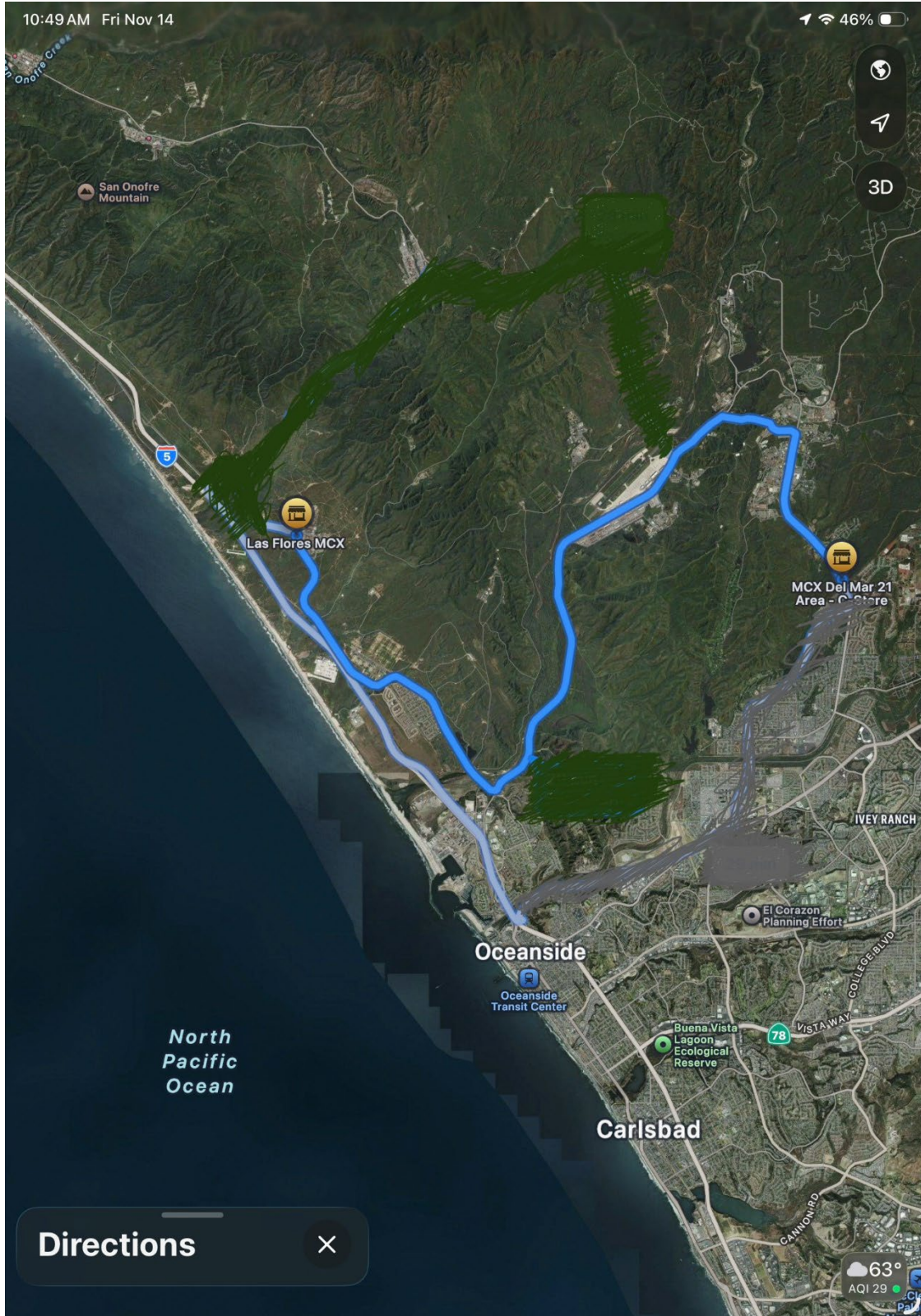
From San Clemente Outlet to 52 Area SOI West Camp Pendleton

From 21 Area MCX Camp Pendleton to Oceanside Transit Center

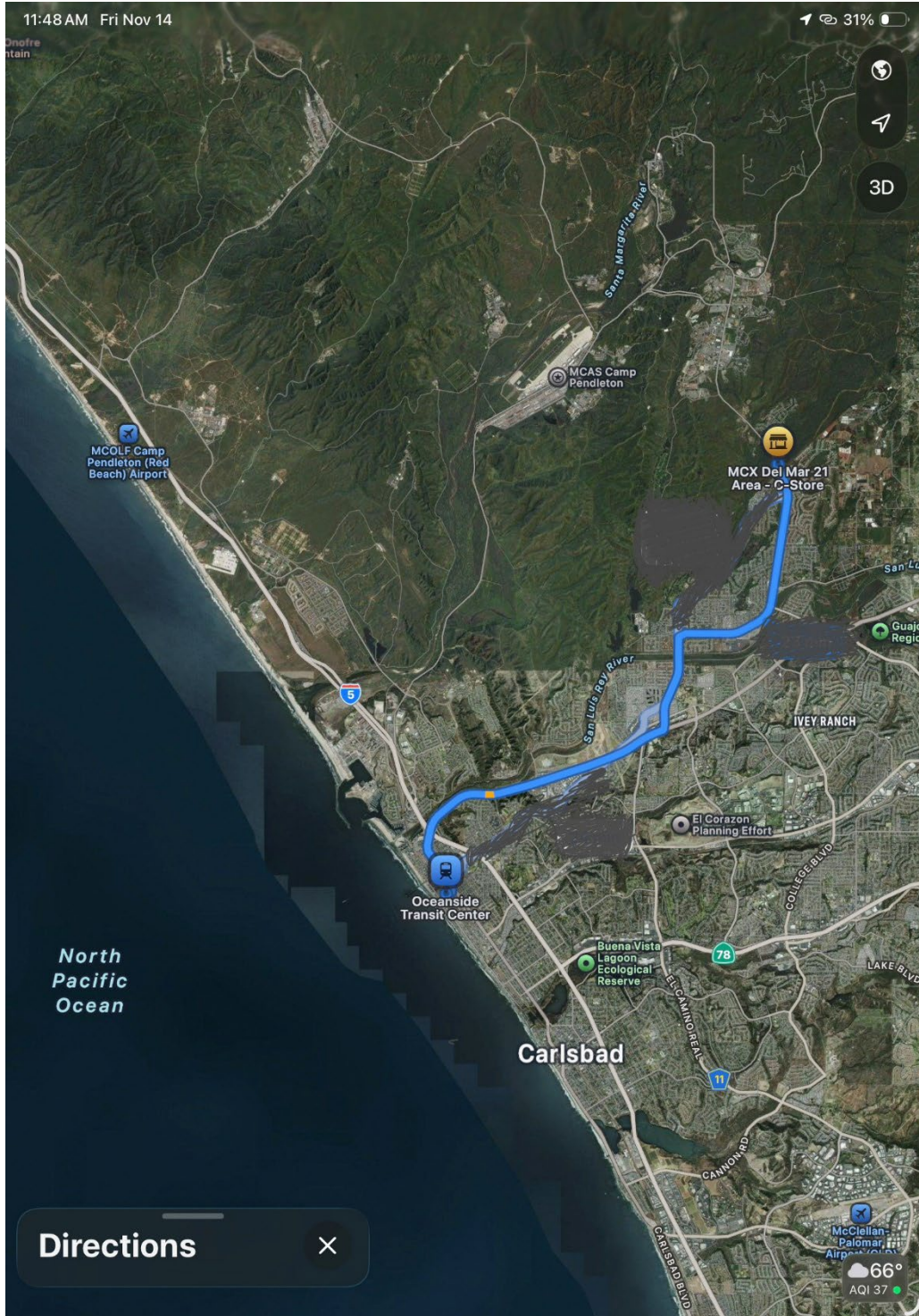

The above-named Carrier, having made written application to the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California for a certificate to operate as a CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS, pursuant to Sections 5351 through 5420 of the Public Utilities Code, is granted this certificate authorizing the transportation of passengers by motor vehicle over the public highways of the State of California as a CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS, as defined in said Code, subject to the following conditions:

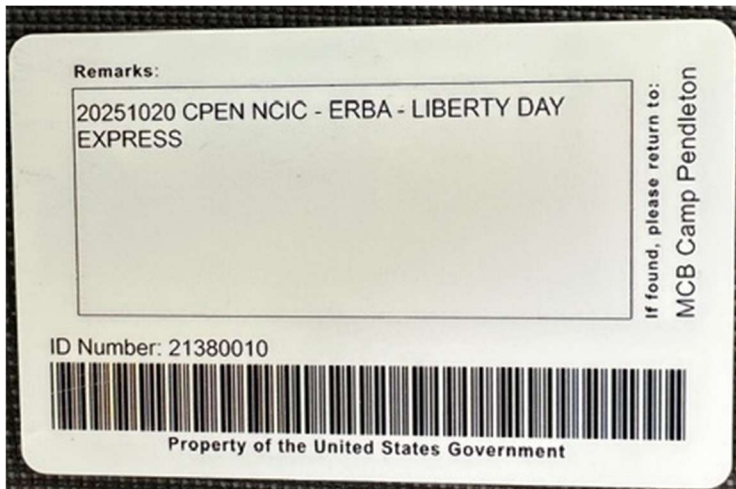
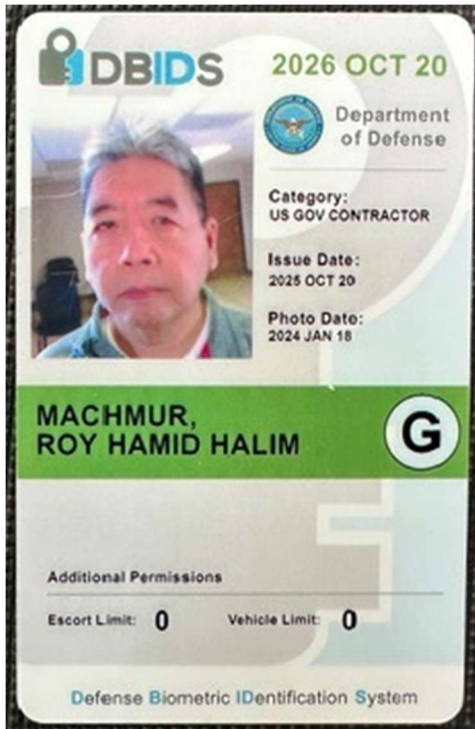
1. This certificate is issued pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5383, and said Carrier shall operate from a radius of no more than 125 air miles from the home terminal to any point in the state. This mileage restriction applies only to vehicles seating 10 or fewer, including the driver.
2. No vehicle or vehicles shall be operated by said Carrier unless adequately covered by a public liability and property damage insurance policy or surety bond as required by Public Utilities Code Section 5392.
3. Said Carrier shall comply with all Commission orders, decisions, rules, directions, and requirements governing the operations of said Carrier including General Order Series 115 and 157 and shall remit to the Commission the Transportation Reimbursement Fee required by Public Utilities Code Section 403.
4. All vehicles operated under this certificated authority shall comply with the requirements of the Motor Carrier Safety Section of the California Highway Patrol. No vehicle shall be operated unless it is named in the Carrier's most recent equipment list on file with this Commission. Written amendments to the equipment list shall be filed within ten days of the date the vehicle is put into or pulled out of service.
5. This certificate is subject to amendment, modification, suspension or revocation as provided in the Public Utilities Code and in Commission Resolutions PE-498, PE-501, and TL-18336.
6. This certificate may not be sold, assigned, leased, or otherwise transferred or encumbered without Commission authorization.
7. This certificate does not authorize the Carrier to conduct operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.
8. This certificate does not authorize round-trip sightseeing tour service.
9. The use of top lights and/or taxi meters in all vehicles operated under this certificate is prohibited (D. 82-05-069).
10. Relocation of terminal is permitted upon notification to the Commission. However, any relocation and/or addition of terminal outside the 125-air mile limit requires a new certificate and 30-day notice/publication.
11. **This certificate expires 2028-03-18.** It may be renewed every three (3) years upon submission and approval of a renewal application. **This renewal application should be submitted 90-days prior to the expiration date.**
