Subject: A.25-03-016, et al.: Ruling Suspending Procedural Schedule

Attention Parties to Application (A.) 25-03-016, et al.:

This ruling suspends the procedural schedule set by the March 2, 2026 Scoping Memo and Ruling (Scoping Ruling) until a second prehearing conference is held.

On March 2, 2026, the Assigned Commissioner issued a Scoping Ruling in this matter, which includes a schedule of procedural events (Section 5 of Scoping Ruling). Section 5 of the Scoping Ruling also notes that the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Final Engineering Report is anticipated to be finished in February 2027. On March 3, 2026, two Public Participation Hearings (PPHs) were held in Tehachapi, California. A few speakers during the PPHs expressed concern for the procedural schedule set in the Scoping Ruling, citing to the timeframe for testimony and the SWRCB Final Engineering Report.

Considering the statements and timeframe by which the SWRCB's final Engineering Report should be completed, this ruling suspends the procedural schedule set in Section 5 of the Scoping Ruling, until after a second prehearing conference is held in this matter. A ruling noticing a second prehearing conference will be forthcoming.

IT IS SO RULED.
