Subject: A. 26-01-009: Email Ruling Memorializing Direction Provided at Workshop

To Parties of A. 26-01-009:

At the end of the workshop held on April 15, 2026, the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) directed Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) to submit a filing to the proceeding with the presentation slides. The filing has been received as a Compliance Filing. Here, the assigned ALJ reiterates that Parties to the proceeding may file comments on the presentation slides by April 28, 2026, maximum ten (10) pages. Parties may make comments on the slides and/or provide suggestions as to modifications or further analysis that may be helpful to consider for the next biennial assessment. Reply comments are permissible, maximum five (5) pages, by May 5, 2026.

The assigned ALJ further directed SoCalGas to provide information about concerning outages that occurred outside of SoCalGas service territory over the past decade by May 1, 2026. Additionally, SoCalGas will provide information about concerning outages that occurred inside of SoCalGas service territory over

the past decade by May 15, 2026. If there are additional concerning outages that occurred more than ten (10) years ago, that SoCalGas wants to include in its write-ups, SoCalGas may provide that information as well. Should Parties want to submit comments on these concerning outage information documents, comments will be accepted by June 1, 2026, maximum ten (10) pages.
