**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING ISSUING
THE 2026 AVOIDED COST CALCULATOR STAFF
PROPOSAL FOR PARTY INPUT**

Through this Ruling, the Staff Proposal prepared by the Commission's Energy Division for the 2026 Avoided Cost Calculator (ACC) is issued for party input. Energy Division's Staff Proposal is attached to this Ruling as Attachment A. Guided by the biennial ACC review schedule adopted by Decision 25-11-005, Energy Division is to hold a workshop to discuss their Staff Proposal on April 29, 2026. Parties shall file opening comments on the ACC Update staff proposal by May 13, 2026, and reply comments will be due May 18, 2026. If needed, evidentiary hearings will be held in May 2026.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Opening comments on issues related to the 2026 Avoided Cost Calculator update shall be filed by May 13, 2026.

2. Reply comments on issues related to the 2024 Avoided Cost Calculator shall be filed by May 18, 2026.
