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QUESTION 20:

Provide the subscription process and costs for companies that use the Unbundled Storage program.

RESPONSE 20:

SoCalGas objects to this request as vague and ambiguous, particularly with respect to the phrase “cost for companies.” Subject to and without waiving the foregoing objections, SoCalGas responds as follows. SoCalGas interprets this request to seek the costs to subscribe to the Unbundled Storage Program. The subscription process for the Unbundled Storage program involves market based bilateral negotiations between companies and SoCalGas. These negotiations determine the costs to companies to subscribe to the program.

QUESTION 21:

Provide the method for customers who do not currently subscribe to the Unbundled Storage program to become customers of the Unbundled Storage program when the program is fully subscribed.

RESPONSE 21:

When the Unbundled Storage Program is fully subscribed for a particular season, SoCalGas notifies prospective customers of the storage subscription process for the following season.

QUESTION 22:

Provide SoCalGas’ definition of “Receipt Point Utilization.”

RESPONSE 22:

SoCalGas defines Receipt Point Utilization as the actual physical natural gas supplies received divided by SoCalGas’ capacity to receive supplies. As an example, 650 MMcfd of actual receipts divided by 765 MMcfd of available capacity is approximately 85% Receipt Point Utilization.
