ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE RULING REQUIRING SAN DIEGO GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, AND INVITING OTHER PARTIES, TO PROVIDE COMMENTS

Within 15 calendar days of the issuance of this ruling, San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E) shall, and other parties may, file and serve comments regarding the following:

1. Provide comments and/or objections to the assigned Administrative Law Judges' (ALJs') intention of receiving the following evidence into the record:
 - a. SDG&E 2020 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) dated February 7, 2020;
 - b. SDG&E 2020 WMP Revised dated March 2, 2020;
 - c. SDG&E Quarterly Report on 2020 WMP for Q4 2020 dated December 9, 2020;
 - d. Evidence of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E's) drone inspection and repair program costs and unit costs, including but not limited to PG&E's 2023-2025 Revised WMP dated January 8, 2024, , and A.23-06-008, Ex. PG&E-01 and Ex. PG&E-06; and

- e. Evidence of Southern California Edison Company's (SCE's) drone inspection and repair program costs and unit costs.
2. Provide comments on why the Commission should or should not use the above evidence to compare PG&E's and SCE's drone inspection and repair programs and costs to SDG&E's drone inspection and repair programs and costs, including their unit costs. Include in comments the page numbers of the WMPs' drone inspection and repair costs and unit costs.

Any party may file responses to the comments required above within 10 calendar days of the service of the comments required above.
