**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING PROVIDING
NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY ON TAKING OFFICIAL NOTICE**

The ruling provides notice and opportunity to respond on taking official notice of documents.

Pursuant to Rule 13.10 of the California Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure:

- Official notice may be taken of such matters as may be judicially noticed by the courts of the State of California pursuant to Evidence Code Section 450 et seq.
- Pursuant to California Evidence Code Section 455(a): If the trial court has been requested to take or has taken or proposes to take judicial notice of such matter, the court shall afford each party reasonable opportunity, before the jury is instructed or before the cause is for decision by the court, to present to the court information relevant to:
 - i. The propriety of taking judicial notice of the matter; and
 - ii. The tenor of the matter to be noticed.

Accordingly, parties have until ten (10) days after the issue date of this ruling to file a response explaining their position, if any, on the propriety of taking official notice, as well as the tenor of the matter to be noticed, of the item

identified below. Each party's response should not exceed five pages in length, in 12-point font.

Pursuant to Evidence Code Section 452(h), we plan to take official notice of the following item of information:

- o June 9, 2023 Solar on Multifamily Affordable Housing Second Triennial Report submitted to the California Public Utilities Commission and prepared by Verdant Associates, LLC

Official notice is limited to notice of the contents of the documents and the fact that they were published and received; official notice does not extend to the truth of assertions or other statements that are subject to interpretation or dispute.
