RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ALJ-494 Resolving the Appeal K.25-09-013 of Citation Number T.2025-09-005 of Carey Limousine, S.F. Inc. (Carey Limo) (TCP 9906A)

On September 12, 2025, the California Public Utilities Commission Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED), Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) issued Citation Number T.2025-09-005 to Carey Limousine, S.F. Inc. (Appellant) (TCP 9906A). On September 29, 2025, Carey Limousine, S.F. Inc. timely filed a Notice of Appeal of Citation Number T.2025-09-005.

A Status Conference took place on November 24, 2025, where Appellant requested postponement of the Appeal Hearing until late February or early March 2026. The Administrative Law Judge issued a ruling on December 19, 2025 ordering the filing of a Joint Prehearing Conference statement by February 17, 2026, and setting the dates for the Prehearing Conference on February 19, 2026, and for an in-person Evidentiary Hearing for March 3, 2026. On February 17, 2026, Appellant filed Withdrawal of Appeal. No opposition was filed.

Appellant paid the full amount of the citation's imposed fine of \$20,000 to CPED on March 9, 2026.

The Appellant's request for Withdrawal of Appeal should be granted. No issues remain for Commission resolution. This proceeding should be closed.

Upon written and unopposed motion, K.25-09-013 is dismissed with prejudice under Public Utilities Code Section 308, effective today.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Citation Appeal K.25-09-013 is dismissed with prejudice.
2. K.25-09-013 is closed.
