**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING VIRTUAL
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE HEARING ON JUNE 23, 2026**

Through this ruling, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) hereby sets a virtual Order to Show Cause (OSC) hearing for **Tuesday, June 23, 2026**, starting at **11:00 a.m.**

As noted during the Prehearing Conference on May 4, 2026, the Commission determined that complainant Konkow Partners LLC's entity status was suspended by the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) on March 1, 2021.

A suspended entity in California loses its corporate powers, rights, and privileges, including the standing to initiate or maintain legal proceedings.

The purpose of this OSC hearing is for complainant to demonstrate why this case should not be dismissed due to its suspended status. Complainant must provide evidence that its status has been resolved and that it is currently in good standing with the FTB.
