Parties and Participants are advised to minimize background noise as well as ensure a clear telephone signal and/or strong internet connection when remotely accessing the conference.

The PHC will be transcribed by a Court Reporter. During the PHC, each time a participant speaks, they will be required to identify themselves for the record. All participants are encouraged to mute themselves when not participating in a matter being discussed.

Parties desiring expedited transcripts should advise the Chief Hearing Reporter via e-mail at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov, no later than three (3) Court days prior to the first day of the PHC.

 - c. Stipulated Facts: a concise statement of material facts on which there is agreement and require no proof at hearing.
3. Public Participation Hearings:
 - a. Expected Customer Region(s).
 - b. Other.
4. Motions:
 - a. Pending Motions.
 - b. Anticipated Motions (specify moving party, type of motion, issues, and expected date of filing).
5. Amendments:
 - a. Anticipated Amendments to Application or other proceeding filings (specify amendment type and expected date of filing).
