**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING MULTI-DAY PLANNING WORKSHOP TO INFORM THE SCOPE OF TRACK 3**

This ruling sets the dates, times, and locations for a workshop in this proceeding and provides additional related details.

A Track 3 Planning Workshop will be held at the Commission's headquarters in San Francisco on June 8, June 9, and June 15, 2026. All dates of the workshop will be held in-person, in the auditorium and hearing rooms at the Commission's headquarters at 505 Van Ness Ave in San Francisco.

The purpose of the workshop is to inform the scope and schedule for Track 3. Parties can expect discussion of substantive topics as well as scheduling and other considerations. Although a quorum of Commissioners, their advisors or other decision-makers may be present, no action will be taken at this event.

Day one of the workshop will be June 8, 2026, and will begin at 1:00 PM and conclude by approximately 4:00 PM. The focus of day one will be a high-level discussion of principles and approaches for achieving indifference. The assigned commissioner will preside over a portion of the discussion, with the objective of assessing stakeholder interest in considering alternative indifference
