Judge DeAngelis,

The Parties have engaged in settlement discussions, but have not reached agreements to resolve this matter. The Parties believe that these discussions may be more productive once a decision is issued on SCE's pending motion to dismiss. Also, in the meantime, there are projects pending permission to operate ("PTO"), which Petitioner anticipates should be issued in the next several months. Once all PTO is issued, the scope of this proceeding would necessarily be narrowed, and would also foster resolution discussions.

Accordingly, counsel for Petitioner and SDG&E have conferred and jointly request 1) a continuance of approximately 120 days of all pending dates and

deadlines in the April 6, 2026 Email Ruling Setting Revised Procedural Schedule and 2) a continuance of approximately 120 days of the November 10, 2026 deadline under Public Utilities Code section 1701.2(d) for the resolution of these proceedings. Counsel for SCE advised that it does not join in, but does not oppose, this request for continuance.

The Parties agree that the above-requested continuance is appropriate in light of the foregoing. A further continuance of the statutory 12-month deadline for resolving this proceeding is appropriate and would not prejudice any of the Parties. Based on the foregoing, Petitioner and SDG&E jointly respectfully request (and SCE does not oppose) that the above continuance of the schedule of these proceedings be granted.
