Subject: A. 25-09-014: Email Ruling Providing Opportunity for Party Feedback
Regarding Marking CPUC-01 and CPUC-02 as Exhibits

To The Service List of A.25-09-014:

This email ruling marks the attached data request responses received by the Commission's Energy Division from the applicants in Application (A.) 25-09-014 as CPUC-01 and CPUC-02.

In A.25-09-014, Southern California Gas Company and San Diego Gas & Electric Company are asking the Commission's approval to review the utilities' natural gas rates and implement new storage proposals.

The Commission's Energy Division issued a data request on April 3, 2026, seeking more information about the utilities' lost and unaccounted for (LUAF) gas demand to better understand the company's assessment of the issues associated with LUAF gas demand. The attachments to this email ruling are the documents Energy Division received in response to its April 3, 2026, data request.

4. No later than May 22, 2026, the assigned Administrative Law Judge will rule on the admittance of CPUC-01 and CPUC-02 to the evidentiary record of A.25-09-014 upon review of any party responses to this ruling.
