**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING PARTIES TO FILE AND SERVE JOINT
PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT**

This ruling sets a prehearing conference (PHC) for Tuesday, August 11, 2026 at 10:00am. This PHC is called to determine the parties, positions of the parties, and schedule of the proceeding, to update the Assigned Commissioner's September 9, 2025 Scoping Memo and Ruling, and to discuss other procedural matters.

Parties and any interested persons shall appear at the PHC by using the following information:

Parties are encouraged to join the PHC 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time so that they have adequate time to ensure WebEx is working properly and to resolve any technical issues.

1. Joint PHC Statement

This ruling also directs the parties to meet and confer prior to the PHC and directs Southern California Edison Company to prepare, file with the Docket Office, and serve to the official service list a Joint PHC Statement by Monday, August 3, 2026. The Joint PHC Statement shall identify and provide the following:

- a. The name, phone number and email address of individuals intending to speak at the PHC, and, in the case of multiple representatives for the same party, indicate who is designated as the primary party representative;
- b. Proposed scope of issues for the proceeding;
- c. Material facts in dispute;
- d. Material legal disputes;
- e. The need for hearings;
- f. A proposed schedule; and
- g. Other miscellaneous issues relevant to this proceeding and the proposed schedule.

2. Ground Rules

The court reporters will rely on the audio from the telephone or Webex to transcribe the PHC. To ensure a complete and accurate record, parties are directed to adhere to the following ground rules during the PHC:

- Mute your phone or audio when not speaking;
- Speak only when addressed by the Administrative Law Judge;
- State your name each and every time before you speak;

- Speak slowly and clearly;
- Do not use a speaker phone when speaking; and
- Do not interrupt or speak over one another.

As this is a PHC reliant on technology to relay statements in verbatim format by those in attendance to the court reporter, the reporter may (1) interrupt the speaker if the speaker makes inaudible statements, and (2) insert the word “inaudible” in the transcript when there is dropped, garbled, or otherwise indecipherable audio.

Parties requiring changes or additions to the official service list shall complete the required “Addition/Change of Official Service List” form and send to both process_office@cpuc.ca.gov and reporting@cpuc.ca.gov prior to the PHC.

Parties who desire expedited transcripts should advise the Chief Hearing Reporter via email at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov, no later than three days prior to the date of the PHC.

IT IS RULED that:

1. A prehearing conference for Application 23-03-005 is set for Tuesday, August 11, 2026 at 10:00AM.
2. Parties shall meet and confer prior to the prehearing conference, as ordered in this ruling.
3. Southern California Edison Company shall prepare, file and serve a Joint Prehearing Conference Statement addressing the issues set forth in the ruling above by Monday, August 3, 2026.
