**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING DIRECTING FILING OF  
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS**

This ruling directs IPC Systems, Inc. (Applicant) to file and serve a response within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

**1. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

In its May 26, 2026, response to my questions, IPC stated its agreement to a stipulation that it provides high-speed digital private line services. Decision (D.) 88-08-059 is attached, defines intraLATA high-speed digital private line services,<sup>1</sup> and shows the Commission has asserted jurisdiction over an interexchange carrier who requests to expand its authority to provide intraLATA high-speed digital private line services.<sup>2</sup> We need the following information before we can resolve IPC's application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

1. An unaudited balance sheet for the previous quarter and a bank statement as of the month prior to the date of filing the application. These requirements are consistent with the financial requirements for CPCN applications in D.24-11-003, Appendix F.

2. Personal identifiable information (social security number and date of birth) for Kurt Adams and Danielle Berriochoa. Please coordinate with Proceeding Analyst Marianne Divina ([Marianne.Divina@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:Marianne.Divina@cpuc.ca.gov)) to relay this information.
3. The addresses of principal place of business for the following affiliates of Applicant:
  - a) Hummingbird Circle LLC; and
  - b) Pike Street, LLC.
4. List all individuals who are acting as an officer or in a principal role for the company and provide resumes in an updated Appendix G of the application, including Tito Singh, Tim Carmody, Alex Baren, Meeghan Salcedo, Vimal Vel, Daniel Villagomez, and Matt Stocker. IPC shall coordinate with Proceeding Analyst Marianne Divina to provide any necessary personal identifiable information for company's the officers and principals.

If IPC needs clarifications regarding the required information, IPC may contact the assigned Administrative Law Judge by email at [Darryl.Gruen@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:Darryl.Gruen@cpuc.ca.gov), copying the service list. Within 10 business days of the date of this ruling, IPC shall provide the additional information as directed herein. Failure to provide the additional information may result in dismissal of A.25-09-002 for failure to prosecute. Applicant's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry," otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.
