To the service list in Rulemaking 25-02-005:

This email ruling (1) marks and identifies the exhibits listed below, and (2) provides notice of the attorney and witness attestations that participants will be asked to make at the evidentiary hearing tomorrow. Any corrections that need to be made to the Exhibit List Table below will be addressed at the beginning of tomorrow's hearing.

Parties that have proffered cross examination exhibits must be prepared to identify a witness to sponsor each cross exhibit prior to its use. Parties may list counsel as the sponsoring witness for a cross examination exhibit if counsel can attest to the exhibit's authenticity. As an alternative, parties may stipulate to the authenticity of cross examination exhibits lacking a sponsoring witness. Such stipulations must be made on the record prior to the use of the exhibit for cross examination. At the beginning of the hearing tomorrow, I will ask for sponsoring witnesses for the cross examination exhibits listed below or for stipulations as to their authenticity.

As mentioned in my May 14, 2026, ruling providing notice of the evidentiary hearing and providing instructions, I intend for admission of exhibits to be addressed via paper motions following the hearing. However, if we have time to address motions for admission at the end of tomorrow's hearing, we will do so.

In response to my May 14, 2026, ruling, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), Southern California Edison Company (SCE), and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E; collectively, the Joint IOUs) and California Community Choice Association (CalCCA) served cross examination exhibits on May 28, 2026. These parties, and the Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates), have also served direct and/or reply/rebuttal testimony on March 2, 2026, and March 23, 2026, respectively; these parties have also served direct and/or reply/rebuttal testimony responding to a staff report on May 12, 2026, and May 22, 2026, respectively.
