Pursuant to Rule 8.4(a) of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure, United States Hispanic Business Council (“USHBC”) hereby gives notice of a communication in the above-captioned proceeding with Commissioner Matthew Baker’s Advisor, Steve Neal, and President John Reynolds’s Senior Advisor, Michael Mullaney.

The meeting occurred on June 8, 2026, at 5:00 pm EDT as a virtual meeting via Webex and was intended to express USHBC’s support for the proposed merger between Charter Communications, Inc., Charter Communications Holdings, LLC (collectively “Charter”), and Cox Enterprises, Inc. (“CEI”). During the virtual meeting, USHBC expressed support for the timely approval of the proposed transaction, discussed the anticipated benefits of the merger for California’s small businesses, consumers, and underserved communities, and highlighted the importance of continued private-sector investment in broadband infrastructure, digital equity, affordability, network reliability, and next-generation connectivity through the State of California.

The discussion lasted approximately 20 minutes.

No written materials were presented.

The non-Commissioner attendees in this meeting were Javier Palomarez, President and CEO, USHBC; Sabrina Gonzalez, VP and Chief of Staff, USHBC; and Mateo Pierce-Mosquera, Legislative and Public Affairs Director, USHBC.
