ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING DIRECTING FILING OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS

This ruling directs altafiber Extended Territories California LLC (altafiber) to file and serve a response within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

1. Background

On December 17, 2025, altafiber filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide: (1) full facilities-based and resold competitive local exchange service in the service territories of all the uniform regulatory framework incumbent local exchange carriers; (2) full facilities-based and resold interexchange service throughout California; and (3) fixed interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol within the service territories of uniform regulatory framework incumbent local exchange carriers (Application).

2. Discussion

Upon review of the Application, I require the following additional information:

1. Please describe the relationship between altafiber and Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. and Hawaiian Telcom Services Company, Inc.

2. Please disclose whether anyone acting in a management capacity for altafiber is currently or has formerly been an affiliate, officer, director, partner, agent, or owner of Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. and/or Hawaiian Telcom Services Company, Inc.
 - a. If a person or persons acting in a management capacity for altafiber is currently or has formerly been an affiliate, officer, director, partner, agent, or owner of Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. and/or Hawaiian Telcom Services Company, Inc. (together, companies), please disclose whether one or both of the companies previously filed for bankruptcy, including Chapter 11 bankruptcy in 2008. In addition, explain the actions one or both of the companies took to resolve the bankruptcy(cies).
3. Has altafiber, any of its affiliates, officers, directors, partners, agents, or owners (directly or indirectly) of more than 10 percent of altafiber, or anyone acting in a management capacity for altafiber, held one of these positions with a company that filed for bankruptcy?
4. Please provide identifiable information regarding Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. and Hawaiian Telcom Services Company, Inc., including current business address, Taxpayer Identification Number, and telephone number.
5. Are there any additional clarifications necessary to understand the relationship between altafiber and any Hawaiian affiliates, including, but not limited to, Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. and Hawaiian Telcom Services Company, Inc.?

If there are clarifications needed regarding the required information, altafiber may contact me by email at Suman.Mathews@cpuc.ca.gov, copying the service list. Within 10 days of the date of this ruling, altafiber shall provide the additional information as directed. Failure to provide the additional information

may result in dismissal of the Application for failure to prosecute. Applicant's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry."
