**MOTION OF THE PUBLIC ADVOCATES OFFICE
TO ADMIT EXHIBITS INTO EVIDENCE; [PROPOSED] ORDER**

The Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates) respectfully submits this Motion to Admit Exhibits CA-01 and CA-02 (Exhibits) into Evidence (Motion to Admit) in the above-referenced proceeding. The Motion to Admit is submitted pursuant to Rules 11.1, 13.7, and 13.8 of the California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules), and the assigned Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ) June 2, 2026 *Email Ruling Setting Final Dates for Motions to Move Documentary Evidence into the Record and Responses to those Motions* (Ruling for Motions).¹

I. INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

On April 24, 2026, pursuant to the Assigned Commissioner's January 27, 2026 *Assigned Commissioner's Scoping Memo and Ruling*,² Cal Advocates served its *Opening Testimony on Application of PacifiCorp to Continue its Energy Efficiency Programs, the Surcharge to Fund Public Purpose Programs, and Bridge Funding for Program Year 2027* (Testimony), which was marked as Exhibit CA-01. Cal Advocates' Exhibit CA-01 was served on the Application (A.) 25-09-016 service list, including ALJ Kao.

On June 1, 2026, the assigned ALJ issued an *Email Ruling Confirming Evidentiary Hearing Not Needed* (June 1, 2026, Email Ruling). The assigned ALJ acknowledges that no motions for evidentiary hearings were filed as of the deadline for such motions. Therefore, the June 1, 2026, Email Ruling confirms that evidentiary hearings are not needed and that the ALJ removed the hearings from the Commission’s hearing calendar.

On June 2, 2026, the assigned ALJ issued the Ruling for Motions.³ In the Ruling for Motions, the assigned ALJ set the dates by which parties are to submit motions to admit testimony into the record and responses to those motions. The assigned ALJ confirms that motions to move prepared testimony into the record may be filed and served by no later than June 12, 2026, with responses to June 12, 2026 motions to move prepared testimony into the record due no later than June 19, 2026.⁴

On June 3, 2026, Cal Advocates issued its Data Request No. Cal Advocates KH-PC-2026-2 (the DR) to PacifiCorp, an Oregon Company (PacifiCorp). PacifiCorp timely submitted its response to the DR on June 10, 2026 (Response to DR). Cal Advocates has marked the Response to DR as Exhibit CA-02. Prior to filing this Motion to Admit, Exhibit CA-02 was submitted as a supporting document in this proceeding using the Electronic Filing System on the Commission’s website.

Cal Advocates submits this Motion to Admit to request that its Testimony and PacifiCorp’s Response to DR be admitted into evidence. Cal Advocates has listed its Exhibits in Table 1 below:

II. DISCUSSION

Exhibit CA-02 includes documentary evidence provided by PacifiCorp which Cal Advocates will rely upon in reaching its conclusions and recommendations in briefs.

III. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Cal Advocates respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Admit and admit Exhibits CA-01 and CA-02 into the evidentiary record for this proceeding.
