**MOTION TO CONSIDER DRAFT 2026 RENEWABLE PORTFOLIO STANDARD
PROCUREMENT PLAN OF CLEANPOWERSF TIMELY FILED**

In accordance with Rule 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, CleanPowerSF respectfully requests that the Draft 2026 Renewables Portfolio Standard Procurement Plan of CleanPowerSF (“CleanPowerSF’s Draft 2026 RPS Plan” or “Plan”) be considered timely filed.¹ The Plan was due at 5:00 pm on June 12, 2026. CleanPowerSF filed and served the Plan after 5:00 pm on June 12. The docket office accepted the filing of the Plan with a filing date of June 15.

Good cause exists to accept CleanPowerSF’s Draft 2026 RPS Plan as timely filed on June 12, 2026. CleanPowerSF attempted to file the Plan on the Commission e-filing portal before 5:00 pm but encountered technical difficulties with the uploading process. CleanPowerSF was able to resolve the issue and filed the plan almost two hours after it initially tried to file.² The plan was served later that evening.
