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Pursuant to Rule 11.4 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, the California Community Choice Association¹ (CalCCA) hereby submits this motion for leave to file under seal the confidential version of its June 16, 2026 *California Community Choice Association’s Track Two Opening Brief* (Brief) in the above-captioned proceeding.

The Brief contains information (and statements derived from information) that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and Southern California Edison Company (SCE) have separately claimed as confidential, originally provided in (together, the Documents):

- CCA-18C (PG&E’s Response to CalCCA 6.01 and 6.02).
- CCA-19C (SCE’s Response to CalCCA 6.01 and 6.02).
- CCA-04C, Attachments A and B (Attachments to Track 2 Rebuttal Testimony of Brian Dickman on Behalf of the California Community Choice Association).

The Brief references confidential portions of the Documents or relates to market-sensitive information regarding PG&E's and SCE's projected market position on renewable energy credits in 2026 and 2027, the status of PG&E's and SCE's bank of renewable energy credits, and the various strategies of PG&E and SCE regarding their respective Renewable Portfolio Standard positions. The confidential treatment of the portions of the Brief referring to the Documents is appropriate for the reasons stated in the witness confidentiality declarations provide by PG&E and SCE along with the data request responses included in Ex. CCA-18C, Ex. CCA-19C, and CalCCA-04C Attachments A and B, or referenced in the confidential hearing session. These confidentiality declarations state that the information contained in the responses that PG&E or SCE are seeking to protect constitutes confidential market sensitive data and information within the scope of Public Utilities Code Section 454.5(g) or is confidential pursuant to Decision (D.) 06-06-066, D.08-04-023, and D.14-10-033. This information is not already public, and cannot be aggregated, redacted, summarized, or otherwise protected in a way that allows partial disclosure. CalCCA is not challenging the need for confidential treatment of these underlying facts.

For the foregoing reasons, CalCCA moves to file the confidential version of its Brief in the above-captioned docket under seal.

² CalCCA has not yet received a transcript of the confidential sessions of the June 2, 2026 hearing, and will be filing a version of its Opening Brief adding those references once it does.
