CHARTER COMMUNICATIONS, INC. AND CHARTER COMMUNICATIONS HOLDINGS, LLC'S NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

Pursuant to Rule 8.4(a) of the California Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, Charter Communications, Inc. and Charter Communications Holdings, LLC (collectively, "Charter") hereby provide notice of an ex parte communication in the above-captioned proceeding with Victor Smith, Deputy Chief of Staff to Commissioner Darcie Houck; Benjamin Menzies, Advisor to Commissioner Darcie Houck; and Julian Buchwalter, Advisor to Commissioner Karen Douglas.

The meeting was held by videoconference on June 15, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. and lasted approximately 30 minutes. No written materials were presented or provided. The non-Commission attendees were Adam Falk, Senior Vice President, State Government Affairs, Charter; and Torry Somers, Vice President, State Government Affairs, Charter.

Charter discussed why approval of the indirect transfer of control of Cox California Telcom, LLC is in the public interest and will produce public interest benefits, the comprehensive nature of the settlement agreements filed in the proceeding, Charter's position that the record does not support additional conditions, and the importance of a final Commission decision by August 13, 2026.

Charter explained that Commission approval by August 13, 2026 is necessary because the next Commission meeting is September 3, 2026, only 12 days before the September 15, 2026
