Parties who intend to speak at the July 6, 2026 10:00 a.m. Prehearing Conference (PHC) in A.26-06-017 ([*Joint Application of CorEnergy Infrastructure Trust, Inc. and CMH Acquisition Company, LLC, pursuant to Section 854 of the Public Utilities Code, for Authority to Transfer Control of San Pablo Bay Pipeline Company, LLC \(PLC-29\) and Crimson California Pipeline, L.P. \(PLC-26\)*](#)) for which [by ruling dated June 18, 2026](#) protests are due on shortened time on June 30, 2026, must send an email to Proceedings Analyst Ahmad Issa by 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time on Thursday, July 2, 2026, with the subject line: "A.26-06-017: Designated Representative for PHC." The email should contain the name of the representative, the representative's email address and phone number, and which party the individual is representing.

Each designated party representative will receive a separate Webex panelist link to speak at the PHC. On the day of the PHC, party representatives should plan to call and log into the PHC by 9:40 a.m., 20 minutes before the PHC starts, to test audio and video.

The following process will apply during the remote PHC:

- Mute the microphone and turn off your camera when not speaking
- Speak only when addressed by the Administrative Law Judge
- Speak slowly and clearly, and
- Refrain from interrupting or speaking over another panelist

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The PHC hearing reporter will interrupting the speaker if there is an inaudible statement. The reporter will insert the word “inaudible” in the transcript when there is dropped, garbled, or otherwise indecipherable audio.

Parties who wish to make changes or additions to the service list should send the “Addition/Change of Official Service List” form to both process_office@cpuc.ca.gov and alj_reporting@cpuc.ca.gov prior to the PHC.

Parties who wish to receive expedited transcripts of the PHC must notify the Chief Hearing Reporter via email at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov no later than three business days prior to the date of the PHC. The Chief Hearing Reporter will contact the service list for A.26-06-017 as well.
