ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S RULING DIRECTING LIBERTY UTILITIES TO FILE A PETITION FOR MODIFICATION TO CORRECT ERRORS IN DECISION 26-05-032

After careful consideration following the June 23, 2026, status conference held in this closed proceeding, I have determined that the most prudent way to re-open the proceeding in A.24-01-002, et. al. to issue a new decision correcting errors in Decision 26-05-032, issued on May 15, 2026, is for Liberty Utilities (Park Water) Corp. (Park Water) and Liberty Utilities (Apple Valley Ranchos Water) Corp. (AVR) (Liberty) to file and serve a Petition for Modification (PFM) pursuant to Rule 16.4 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules).

Liberty should convert its May 26, 2026, letter requesting correction of obvious errors in D.26-05-032 to a PFM in accordance with Rule 16.4. The PFM shall be filed and served as soon as is practical but not later than **June 30, 2026**.

Liberty should use its best judgement to incorporate all reasonable input or advice from the Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities

Commission (Cal Advocates), the Commission's Water Division, and any other parties to the proceedings that have participated in any discussions or responded to the May 26, 2026.
