**MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS OF  
ORANGE COUNTY POWER AUTHORITY**

Orange County Power Authority (“OCA”) respectfully moves for party status in this proceeding under Rule 1.4 and 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure.

**I. INTEREST IN THIS PROCEEDING**

OCA is a California community choice aggregator (“CCA”) organized pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 366.2 that provides electric power service to customers located within its member agencies. OCA is eligible to seek Commission approval to administer energy efficiency programs pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 381.1(e) and (f), and therefore has a direct and substantial interest in the Commission's policies governing CCA administration of energy efficiency funds.

The Order Instituting Rulemaking and the Administrative Law Judge's June 8, 2026 Ruling seek comments on proposed revisions to the methodology for calculating the maximum budget available to CCAs that elect to administer energy efficiency programs, the treatment of statewide and regional program funding, and utility reporting requirements that will provide the data necessary for CCA budget calculations. These issues directly affect OCA's ability to evaluate, design, seek approval for, and administer future energy efficiency programs for the benefit of its customers.

OCPA respectfully requests that the Commission grant this motion and recognize OCPA as a party to this proceeding.

**II. NO PREJUDICE**

Granting this Motion for Party Status will not prejudice any party, and OCPA will be able to adhere to the schedule for this proceeding.
