**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING DIRECTING FILING
OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS**

This ruling directs TF Networks, MT, Inc. to file and serve a response within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

1. Background

On December 8, 2025, TF Networks, MT, Inc. (Applicant) filed an Application for Registration as a Telephone Corporation Pursuant to Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code Section 1013 Application with the California Public Utilities Commission. Applicant seeks registration to provide Non-Facilities-Based Fixed Interconnected Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP) within the service territories of uniform regulatory framework incumbent local exchange carriers and small incumbent local exchange carriers.¹ On March 4, 2026, the Application was converted to an application for Certificate of Public Necessity (CPCN) to provide telecommunications services pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 1001. On April 17, 2026, a Telephonic Prehearing Conference was held to

address the issues of law and fact, determine the need for hearing, and set the schedule for resolving the matter.

2. Discussion

Upon review of Application, I require the following additional information:

1. Appendix A of the Application provided a Certificate of Qualification and Registration from the Secretary of State for "B2 Solutions Inc.". The Applicant should provide adequate detail about the relationship between TF Networks, MT, Inc. and B2 Solutions Inc. and provide a Certificate of Good Standing Status by the California Secretary of State for TF Networks, MT, Inc.
2. Provide the principal place of business of B2 Solutions Inc.
3. Appendix I of the Application states that the Applicant provided financial information which was filed under seal through Statement of Confidentiality dated December 8, 2025. Upon further investigation, it was later found out that the submitted confidential document contains only 1 page consisting of the title page without attaching the required financial information. The Applicant should resubmit the financial information as Appendix I and file a new Statement of Confidentiality.

If there are clarifications needed regarding the required information, Applicant may contact the assigned Administrative Law Judge by email at Suman.Mathews@cpuc.ca.gov, copying the service list. Within 10 days of the date of this ruling, the Applicant shall provide the additional information as directed herein. Failure to provide additional information may result in dismissal of Application 25-12-006 for failure to prosecute. Applicant's filing must be titled

“Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry,” otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.
