**MOTION OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY TO ADMIT

In accordance with Rules 11.1, 13.7, and 13.8 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, and pursuant to the March 17, 2026 Ruling of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Brandon Gerstle, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) respectfully file this Motion to Admit Testimony and Other Documents into Evidence (Motion). 
