**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S RULING EXTENDING
TIMEFRAME FOR INFORMAL RESOLUTION**

The Assigned Commissioner’s Scoping Memo and Ruling (Scoping Memo) for this case was filed on April 7, 2026, setting forth, among other things, the issues, need for hearing, and schedule. The Scoping Memo refers the parties to the Commission’s Energy Division (ED) to facilitate an informal resolution to the issues in the complaint. The Scoping Memo sets July 1, 2026, as an initial target date for an informal resolution to be achieved.¹

At the June 24, 2026, check in with parties, ED, and the Assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), it was determined that additional time is needed by ED and the parties. Therefore, this ruling extends the target date to July 31, 2026, for an informal resolution to be achieved. The schedule in the
