Subject: [EXTERNAL] A.25-11-001 - email motion to extend due date for PG&E's further cost update

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Your Honor:

Pursuant to Rule 11.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submits this email motion to extend the due date for PG&E to serve its further Cost Update from July 14, 2026, to August 13, 2026. Consistent with the Scoping Memo and Your Honor's March 4, 2026 E-Mail Ruling Granting, In Part, Public Advocates Office Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule, PG&E served along with its rebuttal testimony on June 19, 2026, a Cost Update that incorporated Wildfire Expense Memorandum Account (WEMA) costs and Wildfire Fund payments through May 31, 2026, and Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account (CEMA) costs through March 31, 2026. The current procedural schedule calls for PG&E to serve a further Cost Update on July 14, 2026.

Given the timing, a Cost Update on July 14, 2026, would incorporate just one additional month of WEMA costs and Wildfire Fund payments (through June 30, 2026) and two additional months of CEMA costs (through May 31, 2026). PG&E respectfully requests that the due date for the further Cost Update be moved from July 14, 2026, to August 13, 2026, which would allow PG&E to capture WEMA costs and Fund payments through July 31, 2026, and CEMA costs through June 30, 2026.

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PG&E has conferred with the Public Advocates Office at the Commission (Cal Advocates), The Utility Reform Network (TURN), and the Small Business Utility Advocates (SBUA) regarding PG&E's request to move the due date for PG&E's further Cost Update. Cal Advocates and SBUA affirmed that they do not oppose this request; TURN indicated that it takes no position on the request.
