**ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER'S RULING DENYING MARCH 27, 2026
MOTION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO**

Summary

This Assigned Commissioner's Ruling denies the March 27, 2026 motion of the City and County of San Francisco.

1. Background

On March 27, 2026, the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF) filed and served a motion under Rule 11.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. CCSF's motion requests the Commission either: (1) establish a separate track in this proceeding to investigate the December 2025 power outages in San Francisco on Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) electric system; or (2) open a formal investigation on the matter.

On April 13, 2026, PG&E filed and served a response to CCSF's motion. In its response, PG&E stated: (1) this proceeding applies to statewide electric distribution system objectives, not San Francisco specific matters; (2) Safety and Enforcement Division is reviewing the Mission Substation event, consistent with the Commission's existing enforcement framework; and (3) introducing an
