**Subject:** A.26-02-020 Crimson California Pipeline L.P. Ruling Granting Parties'  
Request to Suspend Proceeding Schedule

To all Parties:

On June 26, 2026, Crimson California Pipeline L.P., Marathon Petroleum Supply and Trading LLC and PBF Holding Company LLC (Parties) filed a motion requesting a suspension of the proceeding schedule. Crimson stated that on June 16, 2026, CorEnergy Infrastructure Trust, Inc. and CMH Acquisition Company LLC filed an application requesting Commission authorization to transfer ownership and control of CorEnergy's assets to CMH.

The Parties contend that if the proposed transfer of control is approved by the Commission, its approval would impact various ratemaking questions at issue in this proceeding.

We find that the motion has merit and grant the Parties' request to suspend the proceeding schedule in this case.

A status conference will be scheduled for September / October 2026. At the status conference, the Parties will provide the Commission an update on A.26-06-017 and if outstanding issues remain in this proceeding.
