ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING RECEIVING EXHIBIT INTO EVIDENCE AND PROVIDING CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

This ruling receives into evidence exhibit ALJ Ex-10C. On June 19, 2026, the Administrative Law Judges issued a ruling receiving 30 exhibits into evidence. That ruling also provided further instruction to Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) to request confidential treatment of ALJ Ex-10C, and it stated that the ALJs will reconsider admission of Ex ALJ 10-C upon submission of PG&E's motion.

On June 22, 2026, PG&E timely filed a motion for the admission of ALJ Ex-10C into evidence. In this motion, PG&E clarified that ALJ Ex-10C contains the same information for which the ALJs previously had granted confidential treatment in several rulings, including: (1) Administrative Law Judge's Ruling on Confidentiality Motions, dated April 24, 2026, and (2) Administrative Law Judge's Amended Ruling on Confidentiality Motions, dated June 11, 2026.

In light of PG&E's clarification, this ruling clarifies that the ALJs' prior rulings regarding confidential treatment in this proceeding extend to ALJ Ex-10C. This ruling also admits ALJ Ex-10C into evidence.
