**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING STATUS
CONFERENCE**

This *Ruling* sets a Status Conference that will be held, via Webex, on July 31, 2026, at 10:30 A.M. Assigned Commissioner Matthew Baker may attend this event. The public Webex information is provided below in this *Ruling*.

1. Panelists.

By noon on July 28, 2026, each party wishing to speak at the Status Conference shall advise the undersigned of the name, email address, and phone number of each intended speaker. The Commission's IT Department will send a Webex panel invitation to the speakers.

2. Settlement Discussions and Dispensing with the Evidentiary Hearing.

One of the purposes of the Status Conference will be to discuss the parties' efforts to resolve the proceeding without the need for an evidentiary hearing. The parties shall be prepared to inform the undersigned if a settlement has been reached, the general terms of the settlement (assuming that they are not confidential), and whether the parties will stipulate to the dismissal of this proceeding without prejudice.

Another purpose of the Status Conference will be to discuss whether the parties will stipulate to dispensing with the evidentiary hearing and proceed to final briefing. If so, the parties shall be prepared to discuss a briefing schedule.

3. Evidentiary Hearing Preparation

If a settlement has not been reached, and if the parties will not stipulate to dispense with the evidentiary hearing, then the remainder of the Status Conference will be devoted to the preparation for, and attendance at, the Evidentiary Hearing, which is scheduled to commence on August 17, 2026, at 9:30 A.M., via Webex, and last four days.

The parties shall prepare and be ready to discuss the following at the Status Conference and comply with the directives in advance of the Status Conference:

1. The names of the party representatives and other witnesses who will speak or testify at the Evidentiary Hearing.
2. The time estimates for direct, cross examination, and rebuttal for each witness.
3. The list and number of exhibits each party intends to offer. The parties shall meet and confer in advance of the Status Conference and draft a joint exhibit list that shall be exchanged and emailed, no later than noon on July 30, 2026, to the undersigned.
4. In the joint exhibit list, each exhibit shall be labeled using the following framework: a short acronym for the sponsoring party followed by sequential numbering (e.g., PG&E-01 [for Pacific Gas and Electric Company]; and CA-01 [for the Public Advocates Office]). Confidential exhibits should be labeled with the same number as the public version of the exhibit, followed by the letter "C."
5. The parties shall follow the protocol for uploading non-confidential exhibits on the Commission's Supporting

Documents Platform per Rule 13.7 (f) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

6. Hard copies of the exhibits (one for the ALJ [unless already provided to the ALJ] and one for the court reporter) should be messengered or mailed so that they are delivered on August 13, 2026.
7. Whether the parties are willing to stipulate to the admissibility of the exhibits.
8. Whether the parties have any substantive or procedural objections to any exhibits.

A separate notice regarding the Evidentiary Hearing will be provided.
