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Pursuant to Rule 2.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Coalition of California Utility Employees (CUE) respectfully submits this response to the Application of San Diego Gas & Electric Company for its 2028 General Rate Case.

I. RESPONSE

CUE is a coalition of labor unions whose approximately 43,000 members work at nearly all the electric utilities in California, both investor and publicly owned, and the Pacific Gas & Electric and SDG&E gas utilities. CUE represents the interests of represented utility employees at SDG&E and has actively participated

in GRCs since the mid-1990s as an advocate for safety and reliability investment. That advocacy continues in this GRC. CUE expects to submit testimony and briefs to address whether SDG&E is adequately eliminating outdated equipment and replacing aging infrastructure fast enough, timely energizing customers and adequately addressing wildfire prevention and response. CUE also expects to address essential investments in staffing levels, training and safety for frontline employees. CUE looks forward to ensuring that safety and reliability drive the Commission's determination of the appropriate revenue requirement.

At this time, CUE has no comments or objections regarding SDG&E's proposed category, need for hearings, issues to be considered or proposed schedule.
