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Pursuant to Rule 2.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the California State Pipe Trades Council (CSPTC) and United Association Local Union 250 (UA Local 250) respectfully submit this response to the Application of Southern California Gas Company for its 2028 General Rate Case.

I. RESPONSE

CSPTC represents more than 30,000 union plumbers and pipefitters throughout California. UA Local Union 250 represents the piping trades in Los Angeles, Orange, Ventura, Santa Barbara, Riverside and San Bernardino counties.

In this GRC, CSPTC and UA Local 250 seek to advocate for safe and reliable service, including sufficient gas system safety and reliability investment. CSPTC and UA Local 250 expect to submit testimony and briefs addressing whether SoCalGas is adequately maintaining its gas system infrastructure and replacing aging infrastructure fast enough. CSPTC and UA Local 250 look forward to ensuring that safety and reliability drive the Commission's determination of the appropriate revenue requirement.

At this time, CSPTC and UA Local 250 have no comments or objections regarding SoCalGas' proposed category, need for hearings, issues to be considered or proposed schedule.
