RULING NOTICING ORAL ARGUMENT

Pursuant to Rule 13.14(b) of the California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, this ruling grants California Community Choice Association's June 16, 2026, request for oral argument on Track Two issues in this proceeding.

The oral argument will be held in-person at 12:00 pm on August 31, 2026, in the Commission's Auditorium, located at 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California, 94102. A quorum of Commissioners will be present, but no decisions will be made. Individuals must attend in person and have party status to present at the oral argument. Members of the public may attend in person or may access the oral argument via the WebEx information or telephone information provided below. Public virtual access via WebEx will be limited to video and listen-only.

Parties who wish to address the Commission during the oral argument shall send an email to the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and the service list of this proceeding no later than close of business on July 29, 2026. In the email, parties shall include the name of the representative(s) that will be

speaking, as well as the estimated time they are requesting to speak. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and San Diego Gas & Electric Company have been participated in Track Two of this proceeding as “the Joint IOUs,” and so shall collectively be granted the same amount of time to present as other individual parties. Other parties that participated in the evidentiary hearing may request to present at the oral argument. I will set the parties’ speaking times based on the time allotted and may adjust the requested speaking times accordingly. An agenda, as well as any further instructions, will be served before the date of the oral argument.

Written documents and other visual aids will not be accepted or used during the oral argument.

The February 3, 2026, Assigned Commissioner’s Amended Scoping Memo and Ruling states that this “proceeding will stand submitted upon the filing of reply briefs, unless the ALJ requires further evidence or argument.” Additional argument is needed and the proceeding will stand submitted upon the close of the August 31, 2026, oral argument.
