Ruling Granting Bear Valley Electric Service and Snow Summit Joint Motion to Modify Schedule of Proceeding.

On July 21, 2026, Bear Valley Electric Service, Inc. (U 913-E) (BVES) and Snow Summit, Inc. filed a joint motion to modify the schedule in the Assigned Commissioner's Scoping Memo and Ruling filed May 22, 2026. The motion says the San Bernardino County Planning Commission denied BVES' application to rezone land intended for its planned Solar Power Project site. BVES' request to overturn this decision was further denied by the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors. As a result, BVES is removing this project and its financial impacts from this General Rate Case proceeding. This change will affect BVES' revenue requirement request.

As a result, BVES and Snow Summit jointly request that intervenor testimony scheduled to be submitted on July 27, 2026, only include matters related to the Revenue Requirement in BVES' Results of Operation model. The parties further request that matters related to Cost Allocation and Rate Design be included in subsequent intervenor testimony to be submitted on August 12, 2026. No further modifications to the schedule are requested.

The request in this motion is granted.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Intervenor Revenue Requirement Testimony shall be served by July 27, 2026.
2. Intervenor Cost Allocation/Rate Design Testimony shall be served by August 12, 2026.

This ruling does not grant any additional changes to the schedule.
