To all parties and persons interested in the Joint Application of CorEnergy Infrastructure Trust, Inc. and CMH Acquisition Company, LLC, pursuant to Section 854 of the Public Utilities Code, for Authority to Transfer Control of San Pablo Bay Pipeline Company, LLC (PLC-29) and Crimson California Pipeline, L.P. (PLC-26), Application 26-06-017:

On June 16, 2026, CorEnergy Infrastructure Trust, Inc. and CMH Acquisition Company, LLC (Joint Applicants) filed a motion for leave to file under seal and maintain the confidentiality of certain materials submitted with the above-captioned Application (Motion). Specifically, the Joint Applicants sought to file under seal:

1. Certain redacted portions of the Application (the highlighted portions at page 7 and page 28 of the Application, which consist solely of the initial purchase price of the proposed transaction); and
2. Confidential Exhibit E, the Equity Purchase Agreement that contains the formal commitment for the purchase and sale of the Crimson Utilities, which is the subject of the Application.

Joint Applicants assert the information contained in each of the redacted portions of the Application and Exhibit E is considered proprietary and confidential by them. They cite Civil Code Section 3426.1(d), California General Order 66-D,

Section 3, and the California Public Records Act, California Government Code Sections 7927.705 and 7922.000, in support of their Motion.

This ruling finds that Joint Applicants have shown good cause for confidential treatment of the redacted portions of the Application and of Exhibit E.

THEREFORE, IT IS RULED THAT:

1. The Joint Applicants' Motion for Leave to File Under Seal and Maintain Confidentiality of Certain Information dated June 16, 2026, is granted.
2. The material designated as confidential in the Application and Exhibit E shall be maintained under seal.
