Subject: A.25-12-009: Email Ruling Granting SDG&E Amended Motion

Parties to Application 25-12-009:

This ruling grants San Diego Gas and Electric Company's (SDG&E) motion to modify the Administrative Law Judge Ruling issued July 29, 2026 (Ruling).

On August 7, 2026, SDG&E filed an amended motion requesting clarification, or in the alternative, modification of the Ruling to exclude communications unrelated to or beyond the Palomar Decarbonization Demonstration Project (Project). The SDG&E motion was initially filed on August 5, 2026, without a declaration, necessitating the amended filing.

In its motion, SDG&E reports the status of its actions to comply with the Ruling. Also, SDG&E states that interpreting the Utility Consumers' Action Network's (UCAN) Questions 33 and 48b literally constitutes a dramatic expansion of the volume of data to be searched, extracted or restored in some cases, and reviewed. SDG&E thus requests a modification of the Ruling's order consistent with Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure 10.1's proportionality requirements.

Good cause shown, Ordering Paragraph 2 of the Ruling Granting UCAN Motion to Compel is modified to be:

1. [no change]
2. Within ten business days, SDG&E shall produce and serve complete, substantive, and non-evasive responses to Questions 33 and 48 of UCAN's Data Request No. 1, including all responsive, non-privileged documents concerning the Palomar Decarbonization Demonstration Project (Project). For Question 48, responsive communications shall be limited to communications concerning the Project, SDG&E's testimony regarding the

Project's statewide benefits, and SDG&E's collaboration or contemplated collaboration with the University of California Irvine regarding the hydrogen blending aspects of the Project.
