Decision Setting Requirements For Load Serving Entities Filing Integrated Resource Plans:

“In July 2017, the Legislature passed Assembly Bill (AB) 759 (Dahle, 2017) that created an exemption from the requirements of Section 454.52 for small electric cooperatives, adding Section 454.52(e), which states:

(e) This section applies to an electrical cooperative, as defined in Section 2776, only if the electrical cooperative has an annual electrical demand exceeding 700 GWh, as determined on a three-year average commencing with January 1, 2013.

Thus, co-ops whose energy sales do not exceed the three-year average of 700 GWh are exempted from the requirements to submit an IRP to the Commission. Co-ops meeting this criterion will be required to submit information substantiating their eligibility for this exemption at the same time other LSEs are required to submit their IRPs, as detailed in Section 2 of this decision. Co-ops seeking the exemption from the requirement to file an IRP should file a copy of their Form EIA-861, Schedule 2, Part B, for each of the past three calendar years prior to the filing deadline, in lieu of an IRP.”

Please Note: The EIA changed PSREC’s filing requirement in 2020 to the EIA-861 Short Form. Schedule 4, Part A of the EIA-861S contains the information required to verify eligibility for the IRP exemption.

In accordance with the California Public Utilities Commission’s *Decision Setting Requirements For Load Serving Entities Filing Integrated Resource Plans*, Plumas-Sierra Rural Electric Cooperative is exempt from filing an Integrated Resource Plan.
