Update Phase

Parties to proceeding A.25-05-009:

On July 31, 2026, Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) filed a motion requesting permission to submit update testimony on labor cost changes based on contract negotiations and new tax costs. PG&E's motion also proposes a schedule for possible additional hearing days and briefing.

In accordance with the ruling dated August 4, 2026, the Utility Reform Network and the Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates) filed responses to PG&E's motion. Neither party opposed PG&E's request to submit update testimony. Based on the potential complexity of PG&E's update testimony and other factors, Cal Advocates requested that the Commission allow intervenors to serve testimony on October 30, 2026 and possibly reserve time for evidentiary hearings on update testimony. TURN requested that the Commission require PG&E to provide discovery responses in an expedited timeframe of five calendar days.

Good cause appearing, PG&E's motion to schedule an update phase is granted. The Administrative Law Judges also find Cal Advocates' and TURN's requests to be reasonable. Accordingly, PG&E shall serve update testimony on August 14, 2026, and intervenors shall serve intervenor testimony on October 30, 2026. All parties shall respond to discovery requests within five business days. The parties shall meet and confer and, jointly or separately, propose two schedules by September 1, 2026: one schedule including hearings in the event they are requested and another schedule, if hearings are not requested.

IT IS SO RULED.
