**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING CITATION
APPEAL STATUS CONFERENCE AND STATUS
CONFERENCE STATEMENT DEADLINE**

This ruling sets a remote status conference for this citation appeal at 10:30 a.m. on September 24, 2026.

1. Party Conference Statement

The parties are ordered to meet and confer to prepare a joint status conference statement. The joint status conference statement shall be filed on or before September 17, 2026 and address the following topics:

1. Describe the legal issues raised in the appeal.
2. Identify all material facts in this appeal and describe which material facts are in dispute and which are stipulated facts.
3. Describe any discovery and related issues that have occurred and any anticipated discovery motions.
4. Describe any anticipated motions.
5. Describe the scope of prepared and reply testimony.
6. Prepare a proposed proceeding schedule.

7. Whether this proceeding is a candidate for good faith settlement negotiations or referral to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Program.
8. Describe whether evidentiary hearings are necessary and the anticipated scope of including witnesses and time estimates to complete the hearing.
9. Any other issues regarding processing this appeal in a timely manner.

Status Conference Rules and Remote Access Information

A court reporter will attend the hearing and prepare a transcript. All participants, including counsel and the parties, are reminded to abide by the follow rules:

1. All participants shall prepare their remote attendance technology and connect to the hearing at least 15 minutes before the hearing.
2. All participants shall be muted when not speaking.
3. The Administrative Law Judge will address the participants when it is their turn to speak.
4. Participants shall state their name each time before speaking.
5. Participants will adhere to the formal rules of decorum.

Anyone that desires an expedited copy of the status conference transcript should email the Chief Hearing Reporter at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov to make the request at least three business days before the status conference.

The remote status conference is scheduled via WebEx for 10:30 a.m. on September 24, 2026. The parties will be emailed a WebEx participant link for the hearing by audiovisual staff. If the WebEx virtual hearing fails, a secondary participation access telephonic line is available.
